VOCATIONS

The year of the Priesthood June 19, 2009 to June 19, 2010.

Many seem to believe that institutional food lacks not substantial qualities but accidental endowments like taste, color, freshness, and even appearance. Before the arrival of Cardinal Spellman food at the seminary had an unenviable semblance that held the vision of those about to eat. Search as they might no one could find in the many published cook books any of the variety that was served in the dining room at lunch or dinner. Secret recipes with which only seminarians had an acquaintance did exist and were feverishly discussed as their spoons dipped for the next mouthful.

Our association with our first procurator – the priest responsible for all of the physical needs of the seminary – was Father Jeff M^cCarthy. Father Jeff was a pleasant fellow who could easily communicate as he stood with seminarians for a cigarette at the upper field. They said that Jeff had connections. At Christmas one of the connections made it to the seminary. Cartons and cartons, wooden cartons were delivered to the holding room next to the basement under the student dining room where two hundred and ninety three seminarians were nourished. Two seminarians made the delivery, Deacon George Rheineheimer and Deacon Bud Cuniffe. Father M^cCarthy called them during the Christmas vacation and told them to take the two seminary trucks to Bronx Terminal Market and pick up the order at Terminal fourteen.

That order of food arrived Jan 3, 1950 and to this day is still remembered. What was the stuff? What? **OKRA!** What is that? A tall plant of the mallow family, Hibiscus Abelmoschus esculentus, cultivated for its edible mucilaginous pods used in soups and a dish made with pods; gumbo.

Strange but the name *okra* was very unfamiliar to the students, unfamiliar and bordering on the mysterious even raising the speculation – was it safe? When it was first served it filled a bowl and each one took as much as he chose. Then it was presented as a soup – very distinct in taste that was communally disparaged. Served too as a loaf it appeared very striking to the imagination – but it was okra and okra simply is, okra.

Whatever the form, okra was served at lunch and supper for four days and could have continued at meals but each of the seminary deacon class gave Mike Flannery, the house deacon, the reflections of their hearts on the disdain of okra. No enjoyment. Pleading for the okra fusillade to end. Mike gave the pleas to Father Jeff, the Procurator. So ended the culinary seminary trial – not though forgotten. “M^cCarthy’s merciless machination” still gets a laugh to this day.
