Our Rectory

Many are wondering what is going on in the rectory. Dumpsters were in the parking lot and refuse was stacked high. The interior of the house was untouched for so many years it needed renovation and updating. It is my understanding that the original building goes back many years, possibly to the 19th century. The electricity and plumbing certainly date to the 1920's. As you can imagine, a complete new system is required. More power and outlets are presently being brought into the house. The fuse box is being replaced with a circuit breaker. The water pressure was so weak that when one was running the tap in one room, the pressure in other rooms was next to nothing. Since the source of the water comes to the church building, a ten foot hole had to be bored from the rectory to the church. A wider pipe had to be installed and many galvanized pipes had to be changed.

Moreover, most of the appliances were too old to be repaired. At present we installed a new stove, new dishwasher, new washing machine and dryer. We have yet to experience the heating system yet we know the boiler is antiquated. It is a converted coal boiler that is now burning gas.

I am telling you the above for a couple of reasons. First, because the rectory is the parish house, an integral part of the parish plant. It is yours as members of St Paul's Community although it is occupied by resident priests. They come and go, but the parish remains. So, the upkeep and good order of the house is something in which all parishioners should take an interest. It houses not only the priests but also the parish offices and parlors that parishioners make use of.

As time goes by I will update you as to the financial outlay that has been necessary and will suggest ways in which you may be able to help.
