# VOCATIONS



The year of the Priesthood June 19, 2009 to June 19, 2010.

At St Joseph's Seminary a family visiting day was held on the feast of Christ the King in October when the days were bright and the weather delightfully cool. Visiting that one day which began in 1937 changed an old custom. All Sundays less the first Sunday had been possible days for visiting. From New York City via the Woodlawn Jerome or the Van Cortlandt 241<sup>st</sup> subways were easy modes of travel that the trolley ride completed. And small numbers of people used that public means. A change though was coming.

Along the Grand Concourse more automobiles began to appear interspersed along the way moving at twenty to twenty-five miles an hour. A new destination for the Sunday travelers was captured when the beauty of the Dunwoodie grounds was discovered. Between 1934 and 1937 – Depression years – the visitors drove into the grounds and began to spread the picnic blanket when weather granted this privilege. Most of these interlopers had no filial connection to the seminary. They were arriving from the city to make a country visit, to leave the noisy neighborhoods for the tranquil setting that looked across to Jersey's Palisades and to enjoy the comforting sandwiches and hot tea combination. And as this maturing custom was not challenged by the seminary authorities, the increasing carelessness of these vagabonds enjoying a high spirited festival, brought those happy hours to an end. The seminarians were assigned to pick up the discards left by the visitors. A chain was hooked across the entrance of the driveway. No Sunday was offered ever again.

There would be only one visiting day from thence forth, the feast of Christ the King for families of seminarians only.

In my time we all looked forward then, and even recall today, a visitor who was the sister of Sam Chicarelli. She was beauty personified, a blithe spirit, exquisitely feminine, cheerful in her karma energy and a model demonstrating the joys of what visiting day meant.

Sam left before ordination and has not been seen over the years. Neither has his sister. But she is not forgotten.
