VOCATIONS



The road to intimacy has markers that stand out leading to the deepening of that glory which is genuine love restored in reconciliation. No life is without sorrow and the cause of sorrow whatever it be, can open the way to what each person in the innermost realm of the heart desires. Surrounding sorrow are the cries of what might have been in the life experience that person of hope was seeking. What does everyone seek – happiness.

Who in the midst of sudden misfortune that wrenches the heart does not know what sorrow is? Can what is in motion to despair not end in moral or spiritual death? In this day some of the answers can be found in the mix of psychology and religion. From psychology we understand sorrow as a loss of what a person has designated as important for life to grow to a condition of fulfillment. Sorrow is deeper than fear. When the object of fulfillment is threatened with any diminishment, sorrow begins to arise from the depths of the soul because of sorrows proximity to death. From religion we come to understand some of the intricacies that reveal the activities flowing from the soul damaged by the original sin but restored by the Good Friday gift of Jesus.

While sorrow is prominent in human nature, the focus of religion points to the human being's supernature. Supernature, that which elevates man to God's level through the mystery of grace. One in the state of grace is the person who is intimate with God. Still intimacy with God has to be worked through. God gives actual grace to act according to reason in the relationships that bind a person to others. When actual grace is used for good, the process of habitual good acting looms large.

When a person's acts are harmful in their makeup, habitual bad acting forms in a solid fashion leading to moral blindness. In that condition unhappiness exudes the pores of the heart. This suffering could conceive an unexpected twist which brings the realization that one's own missteps are identified as partial to the thrust that is unhappiness. Sorrow rises upon the horizon when personal responsibility is admitted. The awesome realization of God as Father prompts the sorrow of the profligate person that can be transformed by mercy that is a hair's distance from perfect love. At that moment the sacrament of reconciliation is a reality and not a passing fancy. Genuine love out of sorrow has reached into the depths – God the Father is real.
