VOCATIONS



The company of a beloved dear friend is an offering of special affection that over time deepens when awareness in the communication of that love overflows in tears. Tears of suffering and tears of joy form a unity that time and a deepening consciousness focuses clearly and more clearly upon this gift. How often in suffering sickness there arises a deeper mutual understanding in the sick person with the one helping the sick person. Slowly they realize that personal throbbing of deepest friendship manifesting itself in sacrificial serving for the sake of the other. Realization of not being taken for granted and not taking for granted, this hopeful enlightening moment becomes further life giving. Embedded into memory this soothing power of love is an enlightenment stirred by momentary reflection. As a consequence whatever tears are flowing gives vision a piercing hold of the gates of heaven. Blest indeed is the friendship that brings to life love that leads to the revelation that is God's love.

The components of the sacrament of reconciliation have all of the features that make up Godly love. This sacrament generates the energy for working through the blessings of desire for deeper genuine union with the visible presence of Infinite Love, Jesus Christ.

Jesus came among us to proclaim and live the good news and to cast off the deadly weight of one's willfulness. What we know is that we do not easily see ourselves as we really are. That handicap lays the groundwork for moral lapses. Sorrow follows in this course and we do not want to repeat our error. Loss of the sense of sorrow arises with the steps along the path to Nowhere. What is needed is true sorrow that is the begetting of the fulfillment of hope for Life's Joy. Where little sorrow is pulsating, little hope is manifest making for that confusion that is loss of determination to become WHOLE, to accept self as one really is, and with God's help take the next step to freedom.

Thinking about the sacrament of reconciliation, of confession, is a holy and wholesome thought that can open up the vista of hope which becomes the strength of vision restored, the power of determination renewed and the desire of union desperately needed so that the gift of tears reveals the world that has the Risen Savior at center. In essence true reconciliation in this sacrament is the connection to the love story begun at Calvary. Jesus dying, shedding tears, His suffering, yes. And our response?
