VOCATIONS



The year of the Priesthood June 19, 2009 to June 19, 2010.

Time for a change. I received a letter from the Chancery to move from Saugerties to St John the Evangelist, Goshen, NY. That assignment began Sept. 1956 and was full fledged. Not only was there a church, a cemetery and grade school; the parish had a high school. Other responsibilities extended to unfamiliar areas. Goshen was the county seat in which was located the courthouse and jail. Farther out from the town was the county poor-house or as it was called, the Orange Farm. In that municipality was a hospital and four nursing homes, all within the boundaries of St John's parish. The nursing homes were renovated estate homes that people referred to as 'the mansions.' Twelve to sixteen patients lived there. No one from the town would imagine living in those four dwellings.

The original church opened in 1837 and was destroyed by fire in 1879. A new building was consecrated in 1894. I think of the sacrament of confession in these days compared to 1956. Two priests heard confessions for an hour in the afternoon Saturday and an hour from 7:30 to 8:30 P.M. that evening.

The pastor was a distinguished scholar who translated Stockums' six volumes on the priesthood from German to English. Another translation was a twelve hundred page Church history by Algermissen. Father Joseph Grunder became deaf after ordination and in his silence did the translating to keep busy. He was ordained in 1918 in Belgium. When hearing aides came to be, his life started to change. But the early hearing aide was present to await the evolving improvements we have today.

The parish high school was run by the Presentation Sisters of Newburg who were responsible for one hundred and forty students. On Monday and Friday afternoon I spoke to the seniors and juniors. How enriching for me to meet young people who had a strong Catholic faith and lived the meaning of Sunday Mass. To this day friendships made fifty years ago still hold. Many have married and raised families and still live in Orange County. That parish high school today is an independent Catholic school called the John S. Burke High School.

Strange how my awareness of my years is so clear and thinking of those students of the past I see only seventeen and eighteen year olds. All is changing – those youngsters are in their early seventies. Aging! And evolving. Who would have thought that the nine established cold cereals then would today on the shelves be nine times nine?
