VOCATIONS



The year of the Priesthood June 19, 2009 to June 19, 2010.

After ordination the assignment to the first parish – St Mary of the Snow, Saugerties N.Y. My thought, where is Saugerties? From the Bronx where I had lived with my family it was one hundred and twelve miles door to door. A friend wanted to drive to Saugerties and get me settled. He knew the place as a stop before the Catskills. When we took off from Highbridge I began to realize that Saugerties was special. The travel time was a little less than three hours. Taking that trip did not include the ease of a NY State Thruway which then had a New York connection by way of Jersey, Route Seventeen to Suffern which met the Thruway. We rode on Route 9W. No tolls.

We reached the assigned rectory at two in the afternoon. A tradition in the Archdiocese held that the assignment to a new parish meant being there on Saturday at 4 P.M. for confessions. The pastor, Charles P. Burke, was happy to see me, a newly ordained and one who could learn now from this distinguished teacher. His teaching amounted to orders which had to be unraveled by doing. I was twenty five and he was sixty five, a retired chaplain from the U.S. Navy. Chaplains were noted for orders to be carried out without question. So I was to learn.

My quarters were a squared bedroom and a slanted roof study with hoped for ventilation. That Sunday morning at the three Masses I was introduced from the altar and after Mass shook hands with many.

I found out the size of the parish in a short time when on the first Friday the Communion calls that I was assigned were undertaken. The sexton, Andy Goff, had the task of driving me to those homebound individuals. That work of mercy took almost three hours. And shock, the pastor said it would be thoughtful for those homebound of his charge to see the newly ordained priest. That trip with Andy the day after the first Friday was another two hours. Reverence for the Blessed Sacrament meant no talking during the rounds. The circumference of the parish was thirty two miles. Real country compared to the Bronx.

As time moved on, the people were happy to introduce themselves after the Masses and in the stores and along the streets as we passed one another. What was surprising was meeting the people who desired to take instructions in the Catholic faith. This experience of these individuals who perceived the beauty that the teaching and rituals of the Catholic Church offered gave seminary study a special reason for thanksgiving. In the learning exchange with these people seeking and searching for God, they with their enthusiasm of love for Jesus mitigated what could have been a mechanical process of learning. Allowing the warmth of the heart exuding from each member at that convert class was becoming a river forming a communion of persons.

The parish had a wooden schoolhouse of grades 1-8. And each classroom at the same time had two grades

together that the Sisters of Charity were teaching. Childhood daydreaming was not possible in that set-up. Children are the same whether the parish school is in the Bronx or in Ulster County; with dedicated teachers they love to learn. While classroom strategies for learning differ today, the demand of the student to be whole-hearted in effort is the same.

For the beginning priest at Saugerties the Saturday confessions allowed me to look into my own soul realizing the depth and richness of the faith of those people. Their example highlighted the mystery of the Cross, God's love, God's mercy. The connection between mercy and love would over time become clearer in the celebration of the Mass.
