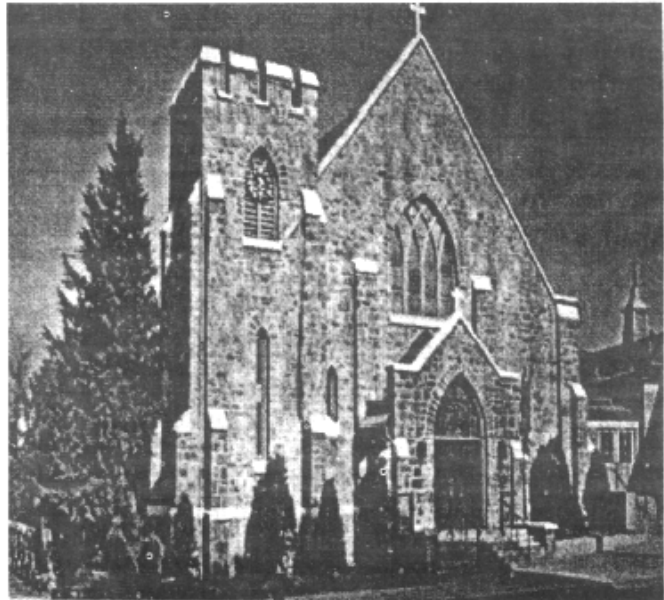

VOCATIONS

The year of the Priesthood June 19, 2009 to June 19, 2010.

In the minor seminary, Cathedral College, the care of spiritual direction and spiritual exercise was not a ponderous matter. Nothing exceptional occurred that was not found in the Catholic high schools of the Archdiocese of New York. In those days, Mass in one's home parish, morning prayers at school, and rosary there after lunch. A student was told of the advantages of having a spiritual director but no check on this matter was ever followed-up.

The changes at St Joseph's Seminary might be described as the maturation process of spirituality. So on Sept. 8th in 1949, the traditional day of the new seminary year, coinciding with the birthday of Our Lady, students arrived for supper at 6 PM. At 7:30 PM we entered a new world adventure – the five full day retreat that opened the door to reveal, in so far as possible, what Jesus expected of each seminarian. A remarkable innovation that was subtly presented as the retreat opened proved to be a mystifying jolt that had all first year students breathing the strange air of silence. Five days and no talking permitted during that time. No talking, period.

The beginners did not know much about the layout of the building so finding one's way was a bit daunting. Attention to the ringing bell i.e., the Vox Dei, the Voice of God. Follow the person ahead of you.

Retreat masters in those days were truly masters. Retreat work was their only work and they were accomplished as we discovered. On each of the five days in the prayer hall there were three forty minute conferences that highlighted the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. Sitting in front in the prayer hall the first year beginners demonstrated adroit attention. Were the old timers behind us in their seats showing the same undivided presence? After conferences with no one to talk with, each man went his own way. Some to the library, a dismal enclosure awaiting the beginning of a new modern seminary library. Anyone would imagine that a library's modern high standard of up-to-date information would offer daily news from the daily newspapers. What news? Two weeklies, the 'Catholic News' and the 'Brooklyn Tablet' – with issues going back ten months. No wonder the seminarians rushed on the free Wednesday afternoons to the Yonkers Ave. luncheonette – for the hamburger, cheeseburger, soda and the 'Daily News.'

Somehow though news of the outside world did arrive in a mysterious fashion. Yankee world series scores, as major league baseball ended in mid September, were whispered through the house inning by inning. That was a day that the porter at the front door had many seminarians there visiting him and asking questions. After all he was a Yankee fan and one not bound by the retreat rule of complete silence while his radio played softly.
