# VOCATIONS

The year of the Priesthood June 19, 2009 to June 19, 2010.

After the first two years of seminary life called 'the Philosophy' we entered four years called 'the Theology'. The step across that chasm was drawn from an ancient traditional ceremony called Tonsure. One who was tonsured in modern times had the hair of the head slightly clipped in the form of a symbolic cross. In previous centuries not slight clipping but shaving the entire head left only a rim of hair around the lower portion of the head. That was monastery style.

Tonsure signified entrance to the cleric state and prepared the seminarian for minor orders that preceded the two major orders of sub deacon and deacon Porter, the first minor order presented the obligation of opening and closing the doors for the seminarians who daily needed to gather in the prayer hall or chapel. Minor step two, bell ringer. At his sound everyone knew it was time for a particular function. Reader followed, a third step. The one to proclaim to a gathering some spiritual thought that needed to be heard. The last minor order, acolyte, the person designated for serving Mass, concluded these ascending steps.

Major orders made up the essential plateau before ordination to priesthood. The sub deacon took the first step in major orders accepting the obligation of the daily office that covered prayer at eight different hours. The final step of major orders was the diaconate, a more esteemed function at High Mass. The long awaited call to priesthood usually was set for the ending of the month of May or the beginning of June. The buzz at that time enlivened the atmosphere of the house. All looked with admiration at those deacons, to be soon in the service of Jesus the High Priest.

Under the direction of Pope Paul VI the orders of porter, bell ringer and sub deacon were eliminated August 15, 1972. This move gave clearer focus for the future priest in considering the proclamation of sacred scripture, i.e., reader; and particular reverence to the functioning at the altar, i.e., acolyte. With the deliberations of the Second Vatican Council about the priestly function 'service' was highlighted. Three characteristics signifying priesthood were set in place; teaching, consecrating and the provision for pastoral charity. John Paul II in 1992 wrote a document, "I Gave You Shepherds" (Pastores Dabo Vobis). The Latin word *pastor* means shepherd and the word was taken over into English, pastor. Pastor goes with congregation - *grex* meaning flock and *cum* meaning together. A congregation is therefore a flock gathered together, and its servant-leader is a shepherd, pastor, priest.

At the Council of Trent 1580 A.D. the essence of priesthood pointed to the power of God. The underlying thought about priest - priest, so what? Thus had Luther asked, how can the priest, a sinner, forgive the sins of others? He can't. God can. Vatican II 1965, the Power of God looked to the priesthood. Who was the priest? One called to give his life, offering each day the oblation of Jesus at the Mass - His death and resurrection. The call of the priest, to make his life an offering in union with Jesus, the Suffering Servant, the Good Shepherd.

With the priesthood as with any commitment, in the beginning --who knows what. To be at peace with the circumstances of one's life, to accept incompleteness and to live with frustration. These will be conditions that interact with happiness, in a priest's life, in anyone's life.
