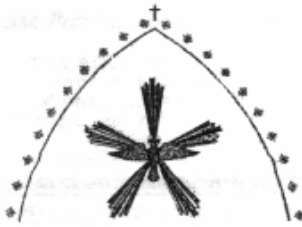

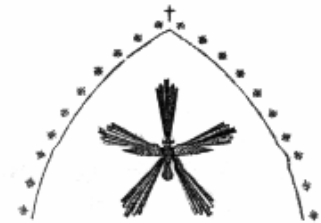

VOCATIONS



The year of the Priesthood June 19, 2009 to June 19, 2010.

The year of the priest, for any priest, is the long awaited and excitedly hoped for day of Ordination. That day in 1950 was June 4th. Twenty deacons would be raised to Priesthood. On that occasion all of the faculty and seminarians would be present at the Cathedral for the wonder of that event. Being reminded during the retreat preceding ordination the retreat master had emphasized "day of glory", not the glory of the priest but the glory of Jesus the Great High Priest – in His footsteps the awareness that Good Friday and Easter could be balanced.

In 1950 fasting from food and water from the previous midnight was still the rule. So from the 6 A.M. rising, Brother Body, as St Francis Assisi, would say, had to be quiet because the Ordination Mass at the Cathedral was scheduled for 8 A.M. After morning prayer we departed on buses for the Cathedral. Riding down in little traffic made the trip more comfortable. Traffic that day was not the horror then as now. Each one was dressed in cassock and surplus ready for the Mass procession. We proceeded from the Lady Chapel area to the main sanctuary.

The deacons were vested in their priestly vestments. What a change! Yes, vestments made an impression within the heart that hour more thrilling. The procession began, the seminarians first and the twenty for ordination followed. Passing Cardinal Spellman each of six seminarians as a unit gave a head bow to the Archbishop. The twenty all together made one bow.

At the beginning of Mass the seminary rector, Monsignor John Fearn, read out the names of those for ordination, each man answered his name, *adsum* – "I am here." Then those men were pronounced ready and willing for this holy experience of ordination. After the Gospel, the calling for the Holy Spirit and the imposition of hands that anointed each deacon began the change. When the handing over of the Gospel Book and the touch of the paten and the chalice were completed, the twenty deacons were now priests and in that role were co-celebrants of the Mass with Cardinal Spellman.

I wonder if anyone at the time, about 9:30 A.M., was thinking of food or drink. The whole ceremony was single in its aim at the heart of the seminarians who wondered when and if their day would come. The silent prayer "God help me."

After the Mass the newly ordained gave their first blessing to family and friends. All the other seminarians returned to Dunwoodie on the chartered buses, there to wait for the newly ordained. Upon their arrival in dining room they were greeted with that masterful, exuberant, thrilling rendition of two hundred voices singing the cherished Ordination Day hymn - *Tu es sacerdos in aeternum*, "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek." The next day we would be going to the parishes where the newly ordained would say their first Mass.

The midnight fast was still in force and Mike Flannery would offer first Mass at noon. Bob O'Connell would be sub deacon; I would be acolyte.
