VOCATIONS



The year of the Priesthood June 19, 2009 to June 19, 2010.

May 28, 1955 was approaching. Time flew looking back those six years since September 8, 1949. But here we were at last in the retreat week before ordination. To define the seminary experience as a location in place introduces the places of occupation in which our bodies and our hearts had settled.

Looking in the chapel, the place of worship, that every morning brought us to the mystery of the common priesthood would soon be changed. Our place at the altar of the assigned parish would be a sharing in the ministerial priesthood, the fullness of which the Bishop held. That chapel for so many offered repose in prayer in good times and bad. How many doubts were washed away after mutual consideration with the spiritual director followed by ardent prayer of the heart in the presence of the Lord. Frank Boyle in our class was the person who regularly reminded each of us to pray for one another. How important not to become too self centered in prayer and to remember that in prayer the whole world forms one union. Of that mix, some are dead, some have been forgotten and some are losing faith. All prayer is transforming in one way or another even when we do not think about that possibility. God wants no one left out. The chapel; Mass, daily community prayer, Stations, Holy Hour & Benediction and private devotions – all for that special meeting with Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

The other room, the classroom. Always the possibility to go deeper into a subject and always the admonition to look deeper on our own after ordination. The dining room was another necessity. Lunch there during Advent and Lent was a tough time. There was no talking as we listened to some abstruse scriptural or theological sermon that was timed for fifteen minutes and delivered by a fifth year student. That was a chore, that is to try listening attentively, without noisy plates and spoons, to the gem that had been so diligently prepared.

The prayer hall was the center for meditation. The previous night the spiritual director gave the points that set the foundation for thoughtful, affective prayer next morning at 6 A.M. I wonder if a few dozed in that half hour. Better to look at myself than question any other!

Last but not least, we see each student's personal room. In 1947 under the direction of Cardinal Spellman all rooms were improved with the facility of running hot & cold water. The morning trek to the slop sink at the end of the corridor for water had ended. A trying ritual indeed. Since talking above the main floor was not permitted, a golden silence reigned. Study without distraction. Time not really wasted.

As we were moving out of the seminary for the last time a few of the thirty-four newly ordained did not bother to take their trunks, stored in the attic. No, they are not in the attic today.

After ordination we waited for a week before we received parish assignments. On that day at the chancery behind the cathedral Cardinal Spellman gave the word.

Looking back over these fifty-five years since ordination, I never thought I would spend my years in four parishes beginning in Saugerties at St Mary of the Snow.
