# VOCATIONS

The year of the Priesthood June 19, 2009 to June 19, 2010.

The time of ordination for the Dunwoodie deacon class in 1950 was getting closer. Mike Flannery would be ordained on that occasion. Another seminarian from Sacred Heart parish in the Bronx, Robert O'Connell, would be raised to the order of Sub Deacon. One evening after supper Mike was walking with me and as we passed a small group talking after supper, Bob O'Connell gave us a wave: Mike stopped and asked Bob to join our group. Bob O'Connell and I were two of the five servers who would participate in the first parish mass at Sacred Heart, Bronx that Mike would offer. I was to be acolyte and Bob, Sub Deacon.

In walking Mike led us from the back section of the seminary building around to the front. An unwritten law existed that the front of the seminary was restricted to the priests of the faculty for their walks after lunch and supper. I figured that Mike, a deacon, had some permission, maybe because he was so close to ordination.

Seventy feet before the front steps of the seminary building is the grand statue of the Sacred Heart, Light of the World. We walked to that spot and talked about the priests who had been stationed at Sacred Heart, Bronx. The pastor at that date was Monsignor William C. Humphrey, among whose many gifts were a particularly wonderful capacity as administrator and an exceptional talent as spiritual director for girls wishing to enter the convent. Bob O'Connell and Monsignor Humphrey were very friendly. Bob's older brother, Walter, was also in the seminary. He left, however, just before ordination to the Sub Diaconate. Walter, after three years in the Marines, became a high school teacher and a renowned principal in Copiague, Long Island. The high school there is called the Walter O'Connell High School.

After some discussion among the three of us we came to the house through the main entrance. Going up the stairs Mike stopped and pointed to the two magnolia trees. "Why couldn't those beautiful blossoms on those now bare branches last longer than two weeks" said Mike. "And the exhilarating scent," he added. "God's beauty, wait for it to come, enjoy it for its moment, recall it as an inspiration," Mike concluded.

To this day when I pass the two magnolia trees, I behold God's beauty, whether there be bloom or non-bloom because Mike was a light to the way of God-Beauty.
