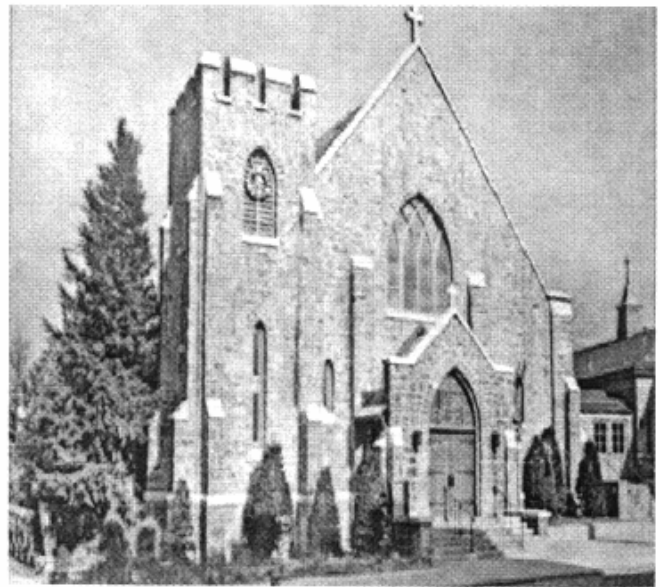

Our Catholic Schools

You probably have heard that a decision was *made with regard to 32 schools in the Archdiocese*, that they would probably be closed at the beginning of the new academic year beginning in September 2011. Three of these schools are in Yonkers. This news came as a shock to those who are unfamiliar with the decreased enrollments and increased costs of our school system. Last year the Archdiocese spent twenty-two million dollars in support of the schools and can no longer sustain such a burden. You may well ask about our school here at St. Paul the Apostle. What state are we in and what of our future? The present enrollment of our school is 201 students. At a great sacrifice parents send children to our school. The current tuition is \$4800 and, in addition, parents are required to pay ten dollars per week in support of the church as well as taking a raffle ticket annually, paying for lunch and supporting the various fundraisers of the parish school. I keep thinking about what my parents would have done, faced with educating their six children. Yes, years ago things were quite different. Our schools for the most part were staffed by religious Sisters and Brothers who, by virtue of their vows, were paid only a pittance of what is being paid today. We are almost entirely dependent on a lay staff and they, like yourselves, must be paid a decent wage, enough to support themselves and their families. And, as you know, times have changed and, for some, Catholic education is not a valued alternative in today's secular world. Not only have some turned their back on the Church, they also do not see the religious education of their children as important. We thank God that here at St. Paul's we have an active and thriving religious education program. We currently have 137 children in our program. But for those who see value in our school and can afford it, the church is more than willing to support it. Catholic schools have made an enormous contribution to our country and to our church. If it were not for Catholic schools our church would suffer a tremendous loss not to speak of the loss to the social and moral complexion of our society. In these days, when human life and morality are in peril, upon whom would we depend to defend the values that we hold as sacred and God-given?

With respect to St. Paul the Apostle School, I personally have nothing but superlatives to say about the parents, the children, and the staff. I am so totally impressed by their attitudes, their manners, their dispositions, their intelligence and their lived faith. However, the parish as a whole has to share this appraisal of the school and be concerned that it must be preserved. In the past few years, the school has depended on financial support from the parish. Last year, 140,000 dollars had to be given to the school to make ends meet and the current year's projected deficit is 149, 000 dollars. To support the school, the parish has to dip into a very small savings account to achieve this but such savings are becoming increasingly less. Some other means has to be sought to financially secure the school. And so I turn to you for your ideas and proposals. I believe that Catholic education is the concern of everyone in the parish, that we must solve this challenge as a family, and that we must do everything that we can to save our school. Please know that I want to hear from you with your ideas and suggestions!
