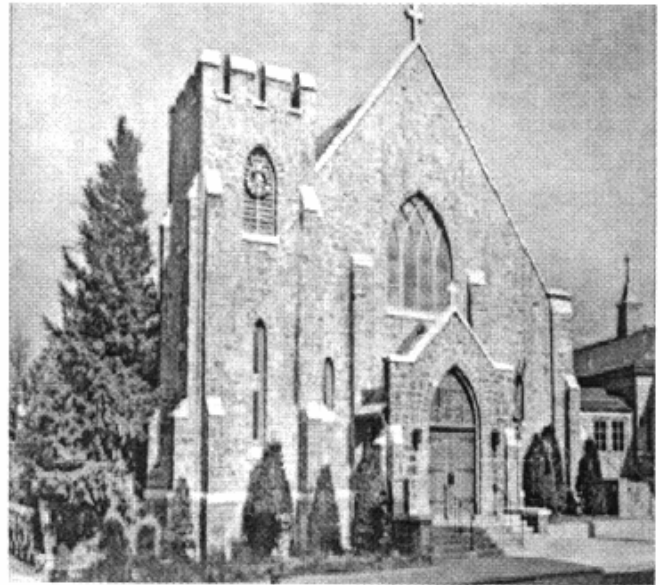

## ADVENT

Advent is one of the most beautiful seasons of the Church calendar. It is a time of wonder and expectation, a time of waiting to expect a birth, and even more so, a return of our Lord and Savior. Although it is a penitential season, it is difficult to contain the frenzy and busy-ness of the preparations that we make. Homes are festooned with lights and displays of the Christmas season. Cards are sent to relatives and friends far and near and yes, there are parties that commemorate the joy and happiness that people feel. All these things are well and good but they dwarf and overshadow the reason which gives the Advent season its meaning. There is a deep-seated yearning within all of us for peace and joy but by ourselves we cannot attain it. We reach out and beyond ourselves to God, the source of all goodness. Advent is the season in which we hear ourselves saying aloud, "Come, Lord Jesus, come." an ancient prayer that our ancestors uttered for the return of Jesus. He was born some two thousand years ago and died at the tender age of thirty-three. Yet He promised that He would never leave us and that He would return again to lead us to the bliss and joy of heaven.

What we experience during this season are the pangs and jumbled emotions akin to those of a mother pregnant with child. This is the waiting and discomfort that precedes birth. This great expectation is mirrored throughout Advent and it is that which makes this season so important in our understanding of the sacredness of expectant life. The care and solicitude that an expectant mother shows to the baby she is carrying should evidence itself in our great waiting for the coming of Jesus. We must be prepared so that we recognize Him when He comes!
