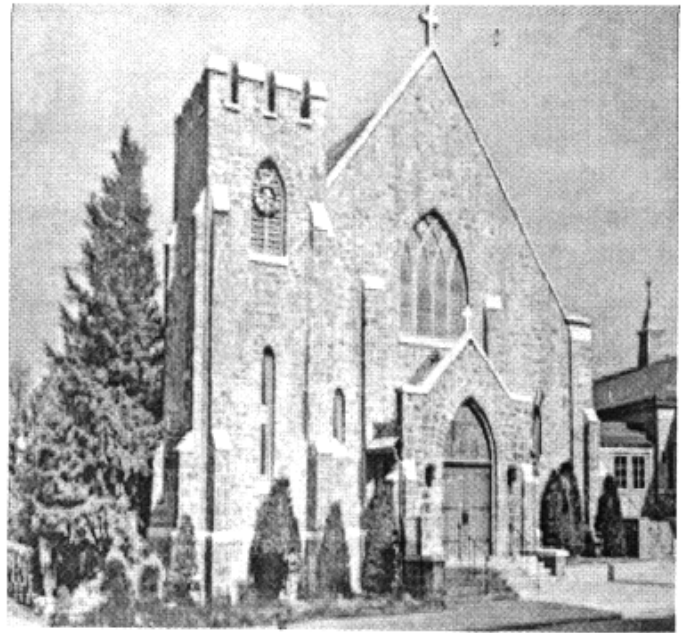

## OUR SCHOOL CHILDREN

Over the past few weeks we have been reflecting on the importance of Eucharist in our lives and of our responsibility as baptized Catholics to be active disciples in handing on our faith and its traditions. We have also focused on the children and young people of our parish. Currently our school enrolls 205 children and our religious education program exposes 130 children to education and formation in our faith.

All those involved in these parish programs are aware of the awesome responsibility that is theirs to minister to the children of the parish. We cannot all be directly involved in the faith formation of these children but, through Baptism, we are all mandated to pass on the "Good News" of Jesus to others.

As you know the Catholic school system in our country is in crisis. Here in the Archdiocese of New York Archbishop Dolan and his Superintendent of Schools are planning to close some schools and to consolidate others on a regional basis. In my short time here at St. Paul's I have been very impressed with our parish school and strongly believe that it should remain a vital part of our parish community. Its leadership, teachers, and staff are excellent. Their professionalism, personal sacrifices, daily witness to faith, and efforts to integrate faith and learning into the lives of their students is admirable. Students are motivated, respectful and reverent. As one member of a recent Middle States Accreditation Team remarked, "St. Paul's School is one of the best kept secrets in Yonkers".

This weekend the parish is having its Annual Fair in Coyne Park. This event is the major fundraiser for our parish school. We encourage you to drop by the Fair or to purchase a lottery ticket. These are available after Mass today. This is one way that most of us can participate in supporting the transmission of our faith to a new generation. The fiscal viability of our school is essential to its future.
