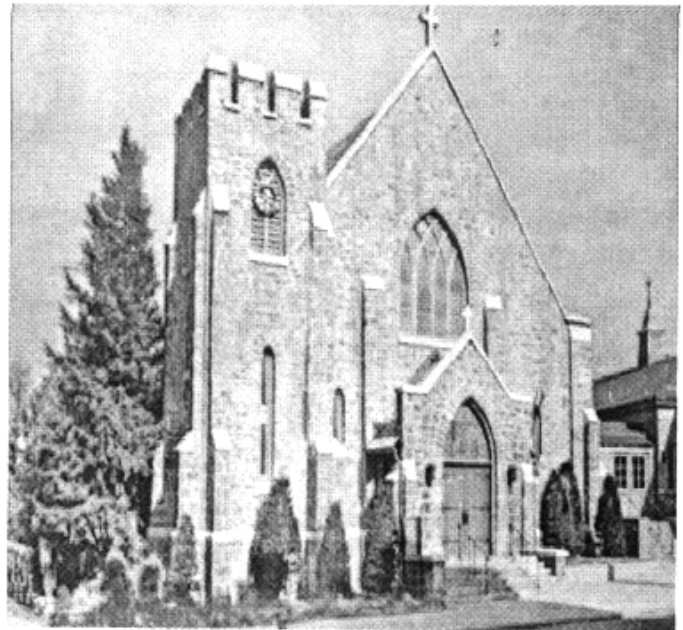

## Our Journey in Faith With God

As you may have noticed we have been writing on "faith" that marvelous gift that God gives us to believe in Him. The act of faith supersedes our natural inclination to think of God as one above us, so much so that we are enabled to accept that God in His merciful love calls us to a life in union with His. No longer should we think of ourselves as being alone in this world of ours: the very God who created us journeys with us till we join Him fully in His eternal life. This is our goal in life – a goal implanted sacramentally from the baptism we received in Jesus, the Christ.

Our ancestors in faith, the Jews, received this call from the time of Abraham and sought diligently to listen to and learn from God His identity and divine will. Moses on Mt. Sinai directly asked who God is and was told He is the One Who is with them always, "Yahweh" a name (or presence) that is so sacred that it should be forever unutterable. Yes God is transcendent (above all) but is also immanent (close to all); that He should never be identified with a material object or idol. God is essentially spiritual yet real. This God chose the Jews as a special (elect) people, as a vehicle of bringing salvation of mankind to everyone. It is for this reason that in the fullness of time Jesus, the Son of God, was born from the line of David, that He came not to abolish the Torah (the law) but to fulfill it. Through Jesus we enter more perfectly into our union with God. We like Jesus are to hear God and to do God's will in all the circumstances of our life. Again when we reflect on our baptism the Holy Trinity is invoked to seal our union with God. The union of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit in relational terms reminds us all that God our Father has created us, that His Son has redeemed us, and that the Holy Spirit sanctifies us. We become and are to remain as temples of God's life.

This union of God and us is the task of faith. It is a vibrant, ever increasing relationship that is sought. It must be protected, nourished and grow. For this reason the church community is focused on the Eucharist, the source and sustenance of our union with God. "I am with you always" is the promise Jesus has made and to Him do we turn as our constant guide on our journey in, with, and to God. Fr. Healy
