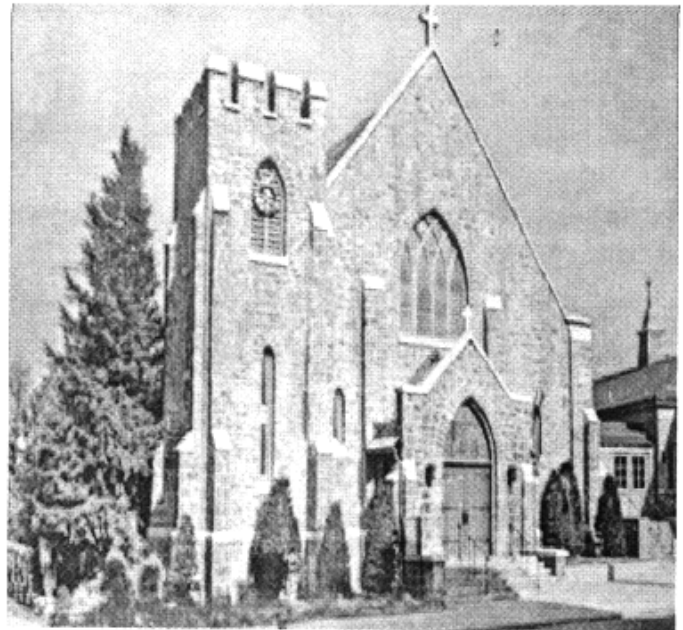

## Our Journey in Faith

Since our journey of faith entails a relationship between God and us, it is important to understand "who we are". In Genesis we read, "God created man in his own image, in the image of God He created them, male and female He created them". Man alone is called to share, by love and knowledge, in God's own life and it was for this reason that he was created. From the beginning, there was not meant to be a separation of man from God. In other words, we attain our identity and destiny in being with God, in loving and serving God, in reflecting this unity for all eternity. However, when God created us, he endowed us with intelligence and freedom, two gifts that distinguish us from other creatures. Intelligence not only enables us to think for ourselves but also to be capable of self-knowledge and self-expression. Our freedom gives us the gift of choice-to choose for or against what we perceive as good.

These gifts have to be activated and used wisely. They presume a level of maturity and proper development. Many factors can influence them negatively as we see in Genesis both in the story of the fall of Adam and Eve and later in the account of Cain and Abel. Pride, jealousy, hatred and even murder can emanate from man's free choice. The original intention of God was to have us share in His love and glory. But man, deliberately, chose to disobey Him. Consequently this choice not only affected our ancestors but was also passed on to us, their descendants. Where before there was happiness, holiness and justice, after the fall caused by sin (deliberate disobedience of God) there was suffering, death and a decidedly altered human condition which has come to be called concupiscence. Henceforth we are subjected to the pleasures of the senses, covetousness for earthly goods, and self assertion, contrary to the dictates of reason. We have been weakened and are in need of God's saving grace that can be found in Christ Jesus. Sin is seductive and leads us away from God. Only in Christ can we be led to the sure path to salvation. ### Respect Life

Late last year the U.S. approved "ethically acceptable human cell lines," so called because they were obtained from "extra fertility clinic embryos with parental consent." Fr. Tad Pacholczyk, a leading bio-ethicist, countered: "Classifying embryos as 'surplus'—is a flawed argument. "There is no such thing as a surplus child who doesn't matter. Every child matters. It is never ethical for parents to give consent to destroy their own children. Calling it ethical doesn't make it so." (*The Southern Cross*, 1/10)
