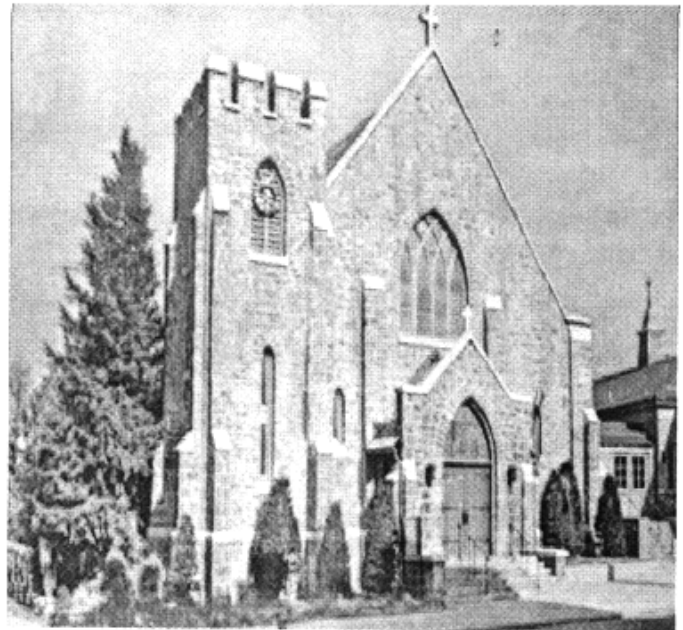

## Our Parish School and Our Faith Community

During the past few weeks much has converged in my mind and heart. I thank God that St Paul's is a wonderful parish and full of potential. With the opening of school, just looking into the eyes of our students, one sees the hope and joy of their youth. One also realizes what a great blessing our school is.

At first when I came to the parish I wondered where all the children were. Certainly not everyone was off on vacation or visiting their grandparents in some distant place. I am vitally concerned that some children are not given the opportunity of coming to Mass, that there is an unwillingness on the part of some to hand on the faith and practice of our faith. And yet I acknowledge they make great sacrifices to send their children to our Catholic school. It almost seems that there is a separation or division between the church on one hand and the school on the other.

For the health and holiness of both, this separation must come to an end.

Our Holy Father Benedict in his recent visit to Great Britain beautifully yet forcibly spoke of the great divide that separates our faith from a more worldly view that pits religion against culture. Morality, the roots of government and our judgment of what is right and wrong, moral and immoral, seem to be heading for disaster. There is a new selfishness, a new stress on what one wants to feel and do that has come about in recent times. It is almost like saying to God that "I" am in charge, "I" will determine my own destiny and lifestyle.

When we abandon God and the revelation of His will for us in Christ, we cast ourselves in the formidable waters of chaos and sin. We sink further and further into the murky sea of confusion and despair. Before this happens let us reach out to the anchor Christ has left us – the Church. Let us open our inner selves to the saving grace of our faith that God can renew and revitalize. It is here at St Paul's for the taking. God awaits us as a loving and forgiving Father would wait for the return of His beloved son or daughter. Come home! Come back! We love you and need you – you are family. Fr. Healy
