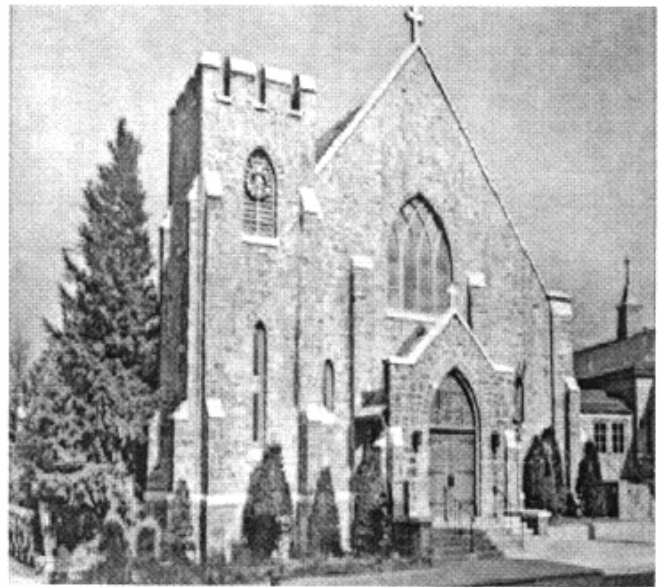

When I was preparing for Confirmation, I was told by my parents to sit and read the lives of Irish saints and to select a saint's name for Confirmation. I selected Brendan, who was a famous navigator and who was reputed to have discovered the "New World" long before Columbus. Little did I know then that I would be traveling all over Europe, the Near East, North Africa, and North and South America. I think that by association with St. Brendan, I was led to these far and distant places.

The role of saints in our lives as Catholic Christians is very important as you can tell from the calendar of saints in our liturgy. We believe that they comprise a vast array of intercessors for all of us. By definition saints are those who have attained a state of glory with God, our Father. This closeness to Him is recognized by the Church through the process of canonization and by the mysterious union they have with all of us, even with those who are not officially canonized. We believe by our prayers that their lives serve as a model for us to follow and that they watch over us and guide us on our journey to God. We belong to them. They belong to us. All Saints Day is the day to remember to follow the breadth and depth of the communion of saints, the history and geography of our faith which is all encompassing, the community that knows no borders, not even those of death.
