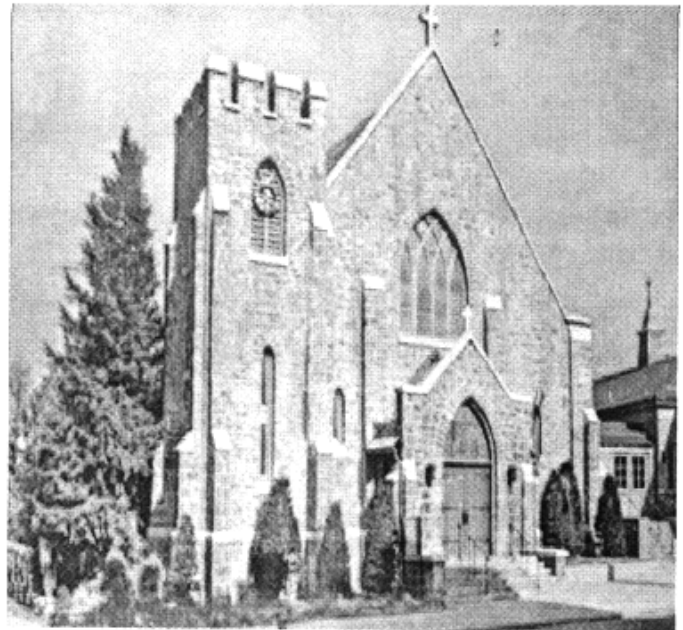

Handing On Our Traditions

I must say that one of the most positive aspects of being pastor of St Paul's comes from having a wonderful school and a vibrant religious education program. As you well know, an important element of our faith as Catholic Christians is handing on the traditions of our faith, to foster and to do everything we can to form new followers of Christ. As you recall, the Church is one, holy, catholic and apostolic in nature. The word "Apostolic" comes from the Greek "apostolein" which has come to mean that we are sent and commissioned by Christ to share our faith in the Lord with others. Just as the Apostles, we must pass on the good news, and certainly that means to our children. "Suffer the little children to come unto me," says Jesus.

Among my happiest moments at St Paul's thus far has been to participate in the liturgy with the children and their catechists. These moments of liturgical celebration bring to life our oneness in the Eucharistic presence of the Lord and bond us in community to each other as members of His family on earth. It is at the eucharist that we listen and reflect on God's word, that we enter into the most sacred moments of union with Christ, our Savior. The eucharist is the most wonderful gift that Christ has left us – the gift of Himself and the source of our life in Him and with each other.

As with all forms of education, the best teachers are those who teach by example, that is, those who authentically live His message. "Do as I tell you and not what I do" is devastating to children. It presents conflict and confusion in their lives. That is why we must be active participants of our church community and solemnly live out our baptismal commitment. It is only in this way that our children's Christian formation can mature, *and by the grace of God we are here to accomplish that.*
