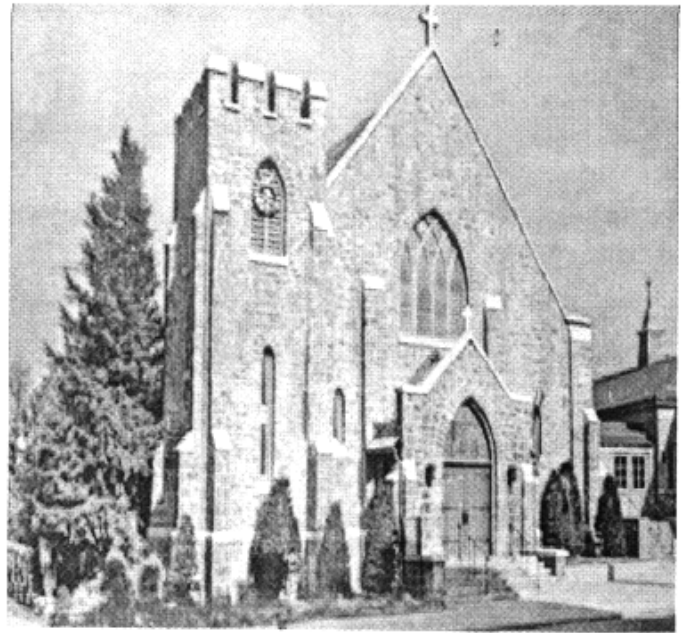

Legalized euthanasia in the Netherlands continues to claim an increasing number of victims--2,500 in 2009. Dutch statistics do not include other categories of euthanasia-induced deaths, such as the number of people with disabilities who are coerced into death by euthanasia based on the false premise that living with a disability inevitably produces a life of suffering. ## Our Participation at Mass on the Lord's Day

Last Sunday the 9:15 Mass was well attended. Catechists, children and parents were present as well as a sizeable group of widows and widowers from Westchester. The Mass was a joyful celebration of families who focused on the importance of Christ in their lives and who recognize the essential sign of Christ in the Eucharist. Without being fed the body of Christ it is hard to imagine how a family can faithfully stay together in this world. Jesus, Himself, gave us this great gift and instructs His followers "to do this in memory of Him."

Without Eucharist the essential unity that we experience in the Church would be destroyed. Not only that, we would be without direction and purpose. The Eucharist points not only to the past but to the present and future. It celebrates the death of Christ in an unbloody sacrifice but also His resurrected presence now and His promise to come again. Let us read the letter to the Hebrews that reminds us that Jesus' sacrifice on the cross is the source of eternal life for us all and it is that sacrifice that is presented in the Mass. Moreover, the last book of the Bible, the book of Revelation, looks to the heavenly banquet that is anticipated in our celebration of our earthly Eucharist.

What is at stake today is a threat to our identity of being a Eucharistic people due to apathy and indifference. Catholic Christians have always been identified with going to Mass on the Lord's Day which from very early times was from sundown on Saturday to sundown on Sunday. This day reminds us of and unites us to the Resurrected Christ. To absent oneself and one's family from Sunday Mass is to imperil the sacred bond we have with Christ and with His Church. It is to put oneself and one's family outside the Church and it is a serious breach with the Catholic faith which has been given to us to protect down through centuries.

Please give this some thought so that we can hand on to our children what truly is a precious gift of Christ Himself, a gift given to His people to celebrate at Eucharist.
