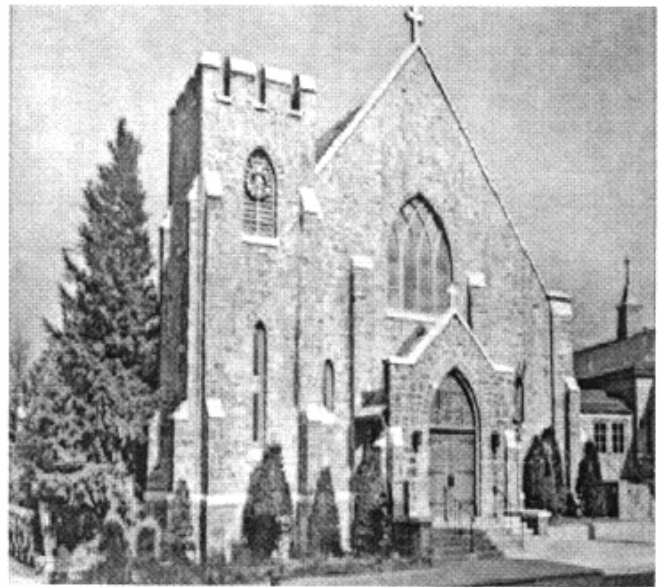

PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Parishioners,

In surveying the history of St. Paul the Apostle Church, I noticed great fidelity to the Cardinal's Appeal which is now the Stewardship Appeal and to the mission of the Archdiocese of New York. There is an understanding among you that God's work involves us all but that it needs to be administered and directed so as to protect the essentials of our faith and the needs of our people. This is the actualization of the great commandment of Jesus - love God with all your heart, soul and mind and one's neighbor as oneself. The work of the Archdiocese is precisely that - pastoral (worship, sacraments, priests), charitable and educational. From conception to the grave and beyond spans the interest and active concern of the Church of New York on behalf of her people.
