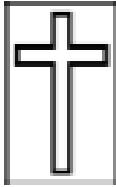

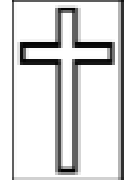

Our Year in Faith - Just two years ago, on May 1, 2011, Pope Benedict XVI assisted the Church in recognizing the depth of the spiritual depth of his predecessor by beatifying him. It was, indeed, fitting that Pope John Paul II be declared a Blessed of the Church on Divine Mercy Sunday. For it was through his prayerful efforts that a young Polish sister, Mary Faustina Kowalska would become known and the devotion based on her visions would become accepted. The future Saint Faustina born in the beginning of the twentieth century did not have an easy existence nor did the devotion she inspired have universal acceptance. After turning 19 she had her first vision of the Lord in which He instructed her to become a religious. Though her parents had twice refused to give their permission she went to Warsaw to seek entrance into the convent. After being turned away on at least two occasions she found a home with the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. Less than two years later she began to be beset by illness. The Lord appeared to her first in Plock and then in Vilnius asking her to commission a painting of His image under which would be the simple yet profound words: "Jesus, I trust in You." He further prepared her to deliver His words of divine mercy. In her diary she prepared the devotion that would become known as the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. While the Vatican suppressed the devotion for a time Archbishop, then Cardinal, and finally Pope Karol Wojtyla, John Paul II worked for its restoration and appreciation. It was he who canonized the humble but fearless servant of the Merciful Lord. Let us trust as did Saint Faustina and the Fearless Pope who canonized her.

### Our Journey in Faith -

The Sunday after Easter has come to be known as Divine Mercy Sunday, declared to be so by Pope John Paul II. Having visited the tomb of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska and read her journal Pope John Paul was convinced that we must turn to Jesus who is always with us, that we must trust in Him and thus will find comfort in all our anxieties and fears.

The message of St. Faustina is nothing new - that God is merciful and forgiving and that we, too, must show mercy and forgiveness. What is emphasized is that we must have a deeper understanding of God's love. In fact, it is a universal love for everyone, even the greatest of sinners. No one is deprived of His forgiveness if we turn to Him as our savior. As Isaiah says, "This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me" (Is. 29:13) and Matthew writes, "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy." (Mt 5:7)

Having just celebrated Holy Week, we read how the chief priests, the Sadducees, and Pharisees, supposed paragons of virtue, turned their backs on Jesus and brought Him to death. Contrast this with the criminal hanging next to Jesus, who called out for mercy and was awarded a place in paradise next to our Lord.

Real mercy evidences itself in a totally transformed person, who from inside self he offers compassion and pity on those who wrong him. Too often we hear people say that they can't forgive because of their memories of the past. With Jesus who forgave even those who put Him to death, He gives us the desire and power to forgive our worst enemies. No one is beyond the pale of our merciful Savior.

This Sunday let us rededicate ourselves to the merciful love of God and exemplify the depth of that mercy to all with true forgiveness for whatever that has happened in the course of our lives.
