Our Year in Faith - In the midst of Eastertide Holy Mother Church reminds us of our origins as we listen to the words of the Acts of the Apostles and the various accounts of the Risen Lord's appearances to the disciples. Each gives us insight into the nature of our faith community. Our Creed, given us by the Fathers of the Councils of Nicaea and Constantinople, defines it succinctly: "I believe in the one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church". For centuries, these have been called the marks of the Church.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that the oneness of the ecclesial community is "because of her source...The Church is one because of her 'soul': It is the Holy Spirit" (813). The Catechism then goes on to recognize: "The Church is held, as a matter of faith, to be unfailingly holy...The Church is the holy People of God and her members are called saints" (823). Cardinal Dolan recently highlighted for all of us the traditional meaning of "catholic". When questioned as to whether the Church excludes anyone, he quickly responded in the words of James Joyce defining Catholicism as "here comes everybody". There is no segment of the population which is excluded from being part of the Church.

The final mark of the Church is that of being apostolic. Again the CCC reminds us that she is built upon the foundation of the Apostles called by Christ. We possess and share the same teachings. And finally, they strengthen the Church from their thrones in heaven as their successors, the bishops, provide us with guidance and wisdom on earth. We revel in the fact that rooted in the past, we stand firmly in the present in our witness to Christ reaching out to a future in much need of wisdom, love, and mercy.

Come to Church! Meet the Lord! Care for your brothers and sisters!

Our Journey in Faith -

After a loved one dies there is always a period of adjustment for those left behind. To varying degrees, an absence is felt. Days seem incomplete without that person being physically present - nights are long, and the passage of time seems eternal. How does one go on with one's life without one's beloved?

This acute state of mind was experienced by Jesus' disciples after His death. They were fearful and confused, but they stayed together. Huddled in a room they prayed and supported each other. And beyond their wildest dreams, Jesus appeared to them. He was alive and urged them to forgive. It was as if they too had undergone a death. In place of fear there was renewed confidence, in place of hesitation and doubt, they were imbued with courage and forthrightness.

Faced with punishment and incarceration, they took to the streets and even the temple area and announced that the Jesus who was crucified and died, had risen from the dead; and they were witnesses to this.

Doubt, loneliness and fear were driven from their minds, hearts and will. In their place, there was the certitude of faith. Yes, they believed and would give their lives to spread that belief. But it was not just their words that conquered the doubts of others. It was how they lived the message - their kindness, charity, forgiveness and total dedication. Upon this lived faith was the church established - a heritage that none of us can forget.
