Our Year in Faith - This Sunday has become known as Good Shepherd Sunday taking its significance from the readings of the Mass. As Shepherd, Jesus Christ, asks all of us, but especially those called to Holy Orders, to join Him in uniting the People of God and reaching out to those who have wandered from the way of grace and holiness. The Bishop who is the chief shepherd cannot fulfill his mission as a successor of the Apostles without the assistance of his priests, deacons, and laity.

Priests find themselves in a world that is in need of evangelization. Values, once accepted by a majority of the members of a society, are now dismissed as inhibiting a person's freedom of action which apparently should have few limits. Progress in psychology, technology and science have not necessarily brought forth positive results in terms of recognition of the dignity of human life, the centrality of family, and the economic security necessary for all. The ministers of God's Word, therefore, must be witnesses to the Truth who is Jesus Christ as were the prophets of Scriptural times and Ecclesial ages. As one who is called to present the Gospel, the priest is challenged to live what he preaches so he might "speak with authority".

Those words spoken of Christ by His contemporaries can only be said of the pastoral minister today if he possesses the understanding that Christ had of His relationship with His Father. The evangelists reported many times that "He went off by Himself to pray". Today's and tomorrow's priest must be a man of prayer. He must be disciplined so that he reserves time in his day to pray the Prayer of the Church, to reflect on the Scriptures, and to read of the sacrifices so many have made for the Church he now serves. Most importantly, as he shares in the liturgical life of the faith community he must do so with great care, be reverent and solicitous that his parish might draw closer to God and each other on their spiritual journey.

On this Sunday, indeed every Sunday pray for your priests for they truly belong to you as you belong to them.

Our Journey in Faith -

One of the unique features of architecture is the arch and keystone (corner stone) which holds it in place. The key stone must be strong enough both horizontally and vertically to support the structure. Without it everything would topple and fall.

So insightful was Luke, the author of the Acts of the Apostles, that he rightfully identifies Christ as the corner stone of the Church. Without Him, we would not be God's people; with Him we are united in one faith, one baptism, and one Lord. He is the good shepherd, who knows us and we know Him. He is the vine and we are the branches. He is one with the Father and we are one in Him.

To realize our oneness with Christ we need to pray and reflect. The great prayer of the Roman Mass, which we celebrate, is a unique opportunity to identify ourselves with Christ. For it is in, through, and with Him that we pray. Remembering His death and resurrection we know the profound depths to which Jesus offered His life for us and the exalted heights to which He calls us to attain with His grace. He belongs to us and we to Him. There should never be a separation either here or in eternity. Strive we must to retain this unity.

Cremains - A frequent question to priests seems to be: "What do I do with the cremains of a deceased loved one?"

The Committee on the Liturgy of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops reminds us: "The remains of cremated bodies should be entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium; they may also be buried in a common grave in a cemetery. The practices of scattering cremated remains on the sea, from the air, or on the ground or keeping cremated remains in the home of a relative or friend of the deceased are not the reverent disposition that the Church requires.
