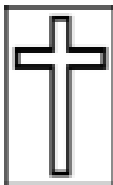

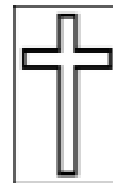

Our Year in Faith - As the Easter season continues, many parishes are preparing to celebrate the First Communion of their young people. It is certainly a time of rejoicing when it is recognized that they make the People of God holier through their spiritual progress. Additionally, it is a time of gratitude for those parents who have witnessed to their own faith in bringing their children to this moment. Indeed they are fulfilling the commitment they made to Christ and His Church at their child's Baptism. This sacred pledge does not end with this Sacrament, or even Confirmation. It has no time limit.

Witness, constant witness is essential for a child. One does not learn how to tie one's shoe laces, ride a bicycle, or drive a car after only one experience. No parent could feed a child only one meal. If they did they would waste away and die. If a child sees how important the day of First Communion is, but then has parents who neglect to take him to Mass on Sunday, the danger of a spiritual death not only exists, but might become a foregone conclusion.

Though it is harder to state one's faith expectations to children when they get older and leave home, it is necessary. One is not naive in knowing what might be happening elsewhere, but one has a right to expect their children to live according to their parent's moral norms when they visit or return home. Before we conclude: a word of consolation should be given to parents who have done all in their power to be faithful disciples but whose children have strayed away from the Catholic faith. When young people reach the age of majority, mothers and fathers can do little in guaranteeing the practice of their children. Prayer is the only method by which a parent at that point can bring about a change with God's help.

Let us pray for all our young people, especially those receiving First Communion and Confirmation.

Our lives must always point toward the eternal life that Jesus has promised. Through Christ we are of God and God must shine through our lives.

We remain in Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit who comes upon us to enlighten our minds and to embolden our spirit. This is a supernatural phenomenon that comes to us through the grace of the sacraments, those wonderful events that Jesus has given us so as to be in Him and He in us.

Our first reading from The Acts of the Apostles dramatically describes how Paul who first persecuted Christians was converted and thus changed, and was charged by Jesus Himself to preach and teach the good news of salvation. Filled with the Spirit, Paul went forth and told all who could hear about his new life in Christ. Imprisoned, ship wrecked, and even death could not squelch his enthusiasm for what Christ has given us.

For us to remain in Christ we must make a resolution that every hour of the day is dedicated to Him. For it is to this higher purpose that we have been called!
