Our Year in Faith - When the United States was being formed many priests came forward to assist the young nation achieve its freedom even though their faith was ignored at best and persecuted at worst. John Carroll, the former Jesuit, lead his brothers to teach the faith to every generation from the cities of New York to the wilds of the Louisiana Purchase. The Venerable Father Michael McGivney spearheaded the efforts of the men of his parish to care for the widows and orphans of those who died performing the hardest of jobs. His spirit carried those thirteen men to become the Knights of Columbus with one million eight hundred thousand members. In the 20th century hundreds of priests joined their parishioners in war as they administered the sacraments to the men before advancing to secure the peace. Like many of them they did not return but were buried in the fields where the "poppies grow."

But we need not go back in history to remember true greatness. In our own Archdiocese we have seen men who administered to the poorest of poor in the South Bronx. Many a youngster was turned around by a priest who talked with them, gave them a meal, and helped their families. They taught in Catholic high schools and encouraged their students to be priests, faithful husbands and good fathers. They struggled with the changes in the Liturgy as they encouraged their parishioners to pray and sing in their native languages. They have been tested by the crises of faith in the Church, the departure of friends from ministry, and the scandals caused by the moral failures of too many. They have stayed the course, they remained true to the task of collaborating with all in sailing the bark of Peter in the direction of God's will.

Pray for your priests. They need to know of your spiritual support. And from Francis, our Pope to the newest ordained priest know that they are loving you as Christ would and they will never leave you abandoned.
