Our Year in Faith - The readings of today are truly an encouragement to us as we continue our journey of faith. The Gospel focuses our attention on faith but from two different aspects. Jesus tells us to possess a poverty of spirit. To live simple lives and to always remember the poor. (A message echoed by the Holy Father many times recently.) He says this not for us to be careless with material things but not to become so taken up with them that they steal our soul. We worry about tomorrow not caring about the day. That tendency cheapens our lives because we fail to see all the natural and supernatural blessings of the present moment. And what is worse the tomorrow we are preparing for might never come because we are called to God to render an accounting for what we have done and what we neglected. This leads us to the second evangelical perspective. When our life on earth gives way will we be prepared for divine judgment? This should not be seen as an attempt to bring fear upon anyone. It is a simple question. We know in our life we procrastinate. "We'll do it tomorrow." Every New Year we make resolutions that we don't keep. But we also say "I have to go to confession more often" or "We should get our marriage recognized by the Church" or "We should be more generous to the campaigns that target the poor, the sick, the young." The Gospel is saying now is the time. This is the hour of salvation.

As the Summer advances and thoughts of returning to the activities of the Fall proceed, let us use this time for faithful reflection and Catholic action. When is the Lord coming? Who knows? But He might not procrastinate too long.

Our Journey in Faith

Today's gospel stresses living a good life and being ready for the Lord when He comes again. This was the underlying theme of the Kingdom of God or the Kingdom of Heaven. The concept of Kingdom was of major importance in the hearts and minds of God's people. From 1000 BC to 600 BC the Jews had a king and a kingdom of their own. However it was understood that God was their ultimate king, who ruled His people through various appointed leaders. As was the case, God's representatives failed. His people and their kingdoms were destroyed. Beginning in 600 BC the Babylonians invaded, followed by the Persians, then the Greeks. The Jews successfully regained their autonomy shortly before the time of Jesus through the Maccabean revolt, but in 63 BC Pompey and the Romans conquered the Jews and were in control for over 500 years. The weight of the Roman empire lay heavily on the Jews and their taxes were deeply resented.

It was in these days that John the Baptist preached that God's Kingdom was at hand. "Repent and believe" was the response that God wanted. Conversion of heart and baptism by water symbolized how one entered God's Kingdom. Like John, Jesus taught that those who were not part of God's Kingdom would suffer, but He emphasized the great joy the Kingdom would bring. His parables and miracles reached out to sinners and His invitation to enter the Kingdom was essential to His message. We must be ready! For we know not the day or the hour.
