Our Year in Faith - When we hear of the opportunities and challenges of the New Evangelization we know that each of us is called by name to develop our relationship with Christ and to bring to others the Gospel of Life which the Pope reminds us is the Gospel of Mercy. The Holy Father reminded us that there are no borders or limits to the mission of encouraging our brothers and sisters to see the power of God in our world and the responsibility each human being has for each other. In his recent addresses Pope Francis has provided for us a unique context for the task ahead. He calls upon us to defeat the "globalization of indifference". He asks us if it is possible for the Church to once again be perceived and act as a dynamic voice of lively faith, enduring hope, and heartfelt compassion.

We can and should be able to make a two-fold response: personal and corporate. With the Sunday Eucharist as the central moment of our life we should take its graces into our everyday existence. We must be willing to leave our comfort zone and visit the elderly neighbor, participate in parish formation programs, and console those who have felt the disintegration of their marriage, the death of a loved one, or the loss of employment. The Church herself provides us with many opportunities of enriching our faith: curvillo experiences, marriage encounter weekends, as well as adult faith formation programs. Within our Archdiocese there are many ecclesial ministries and organizations which can and do revitalize us and the Church at large. These wonderful programs are open to us to strengthen our unity in Christ.

Let us pray for Francis, let us be one with our Holy Father in word and action.

Our Journey in Faith

When I was young, most Catholics had a strong identity with their parish so much so that when asked your neighborhood you would respond with the name of your parish. That feeling of oneness with one's parish has long died unfortunately and so too has one's bond with a neighborhood. For some reason an isolation from one's neighbor has replaced the closeness that we once felt and with that a coldness has replaced the once warm cordiality that existed. This alienation has been noted by our present Pope Francis and in his own humble way he has pointed to it as a sign of our indifference and alienation from each other. It is what we have lost because of our preoccupation with material and ephemeral realities — things that satisfy the body, but not the human soul.

It is for this reason that Jesus metaphorically said He came to light a fire on the earth, that is , He wanted to "fire us up" with enthusiasm for His Gospel, to "ignite" our zeal for the spread of the Gospel and the salvation of our community of brothers and sisters, our neighbors. He came to make of us instruments of His love and justice in this world. But to achieve this He asks for a response, an enthusiasm for the faith He left us. He asks for our active involvement in His church; devout, holy lives ready to serve God's people. He asks that we share our faith and hand it on to the next generation.

Let us pray to share these goals which He had for us all.
