Our Year in Faith - Today we hear the words: "Follow your Conscience". This is a truth that cannot be denied. Saint Thomas Aquinas, among other, thought of it as the highest moral principle but he presumed that the conscience was a properly formed one. The major way it which that occurs is through discipline as Hebrews instructs. We must follow the discipline of the Lord: the commandments, the beatitudes, the Church's teachings, and the wisdom of the saints. All too often we know what the right thing to do is but we do not do it as Saint Paul tells us elsewhere. We must act courageously and put aside our own desires and be disciplined. When we come to a difficult juncture in our life we cannot and must not strike out against God for this is a form of discipline. One that is hard to take but can form us more correctly, if we permit. The truth of this reading can be easily seen if we reflect back on our childhoods and young adulthood. When we were in school, which A did we appreciate more: the A given to all students in a class by an inadequate teacher or the A that came from a teacher, who checked homework every day, who was constantly pushing in class, was demanding in book reports and papers. If we are honest most of us would answer the latter.

Faith requires expression. Frequently, it might be costly but look at the prize: a relationship with the Lord which endures forever.

Our Journey in Faith

Being honest with oneself is a very difficult process to face for most of us. We tend to fantasize that we are better than we really are. Moreover we have a tendency to rationalize our behavior and our attitudes in facing different situations and people. Consequently we think of ourselves differently than we really are.

As obvious in our readings God is always honest and just. He is also all knowing. In other words, He knows who we are and what we have done or not done. There is no hiding from Him. Jesus promises that God will treat us justly according to the way we really are. Yes, He will be merciful to those who seek forgiveness but to those who do not, they will be treated with justice.

It is for this reason that we read in today's Gospel that many will not enter the Kingdom of God. They do not seek God's mercy and forgiveness but rather carelessly spend their lives deceiving themselves that all is good and appropriate. Their rationalization and their refusal to face the truth will condemn them in the eyes of God. For God's truth transcends the chicanery and falsehoods of this world. Our lives must reflect our true destiny. We must not wallow in the lies of this world.
