Our Journey in Faith -

Matthew in his Gospel quite straight forwardly tells us that our lives are a preparation for the "one to come." His direct admonition to us all is simply to "prepare!" As St. Augustine said, "our hearts are restless until they rest in thee" for it is God who can only fulfill our restless spirits and it is God's Son who is promised us as we prepare to receive Him during this advent season.

In reading the scriptures of mass we are graphically told of the yearning of our ancient Jewish forefathers. Isaiah, the prophet, recounts how the Jews returning from captivity in Babylon traced their way back home. As they traveled through present day Iraq and Syria and into Palestine. Over mountains and through valleys they trod expectantly to their beloved home - remembering all that they missed and anticipating all that was to come. So too for ourselves. For we too are enslaved in a new Babylon - captive to all that separates us from God. Sin, debauchery, idolatry, murder and mayhem are everywhere around us. Our society wishes to eradicate our belief in God going so far to obliterate the very reason for rejoicing with Happy Holidays/ Holiday trees instead of using the sacred name of Christ.

Such depth of denial have we come to that our souls cry out to God for forgiveness and redemption. We pray that God open our eyes and cleanse our ears to see what has taken place and to hear His call for us to return to Him. In this way only will we be prepared for His coming.
