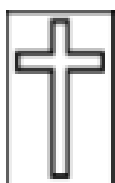

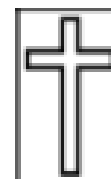

Our Year in Faith - The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults states that: "The prerequisite for making the first step is that the beginnings of spiritual life and the fundamentals of Christian teaching have taken root in the candidate...There must also be evidence of the first stirrings of repentance, a start to the practice of calling upon God in prayer, a sense of the Church, and some experience of the company and spirit of Christians through contact with a priest or members of the community."

The ritual begins with the catechumens seeking entry into the Church. They dialogue with the celebrant and then exhibit the first formal acceptance of the Gospel. The sponsors or godparents speak on their behalf as well as pledge themselves to support them on their journey to the Lord. The community as a whole affirms their support as well. The priest then signs the forehead of each catechumen. This part concludes with a prayer over the catechumens. The Liturgy of the Word now takes place. After the homily each catechumen is presented with the Scripture. After the intercessions they are dismissed. The idea of dismissal is of ancient custom both to advise the catechumens that they must be prepared for the mysteries they will celebrate as part of God's people but at times of persecution also seen as protection for the community. This was called the disciplina arcana.

Before the second step the ritual calls for the Period of the Catechumenate during which there is an extended period...which the candidates are given suitable pastoral formation and guidance, aimed at training them in the Christian life...Among the rites belonging to the period of the catechumens, then celebrations of the Word of God...are foremost. The minor exorcisms...and the blessing of the catechumens...are ordinarily celebrated in conjunction with a celebration of the Word."

It is important in all circumstances that the community is involved in this period. As we continue our study of this important aspect of the Church's life let us all pray for those preparing for their entry into the Church.

### Our Journey in Faith -

When I was a kid, many people would go to the mountains for summer vacation. It was their attempt to get away from the daily grind of everyday life, to breathe fresh air and to commune with nature. Among our spiritual ancestors, they too went to the mountains, but for them it was there that they felt closest to God. In fact, the early Jews referred to God as *El Shaddai*, God of the mountains. And, as you know, it was on the mountain that Moses asked God for His proper name and was told, *Yahweh*.

It is during Lent that we are encouraged, in a sense, to go to the mountains to meet the transfigured and glorified Jesus. This encounter reaffirms our efforts not only to follow Jesus and His gospel but also confirms our belief that Jesus is the promised fulfillment of the Jewish law and the prophets as presented in the figures of Moses and Elijah. The Transfiguration was a foretaste of what we all long for - being with Christ in His glorified life. Moreover, it is an experience that motivates and moves us all to seek God's kingdom here on earth. If we know the glory of the Lord and experience it, will we be moved to change and re-order our priorities, to find ways to eradicate the injustices in our society, to seek to live in peace with each other? "Going to the mountains" is but a metaphor for the inspiration we all need, to follow the Lord and to make, with His help, a better world in which to live.
