Our Year in Faith - Most of the time we rejoice in the company of others. When we hear a concert or attend a play there is added enjoyment in experiencing it with someone. But sometimes some people can be difficult. Especially those who are always negative. If you would like to walk through the countryside, they would call out the name of every insect known to man who exist only to bite them. If you say it is a good day, they will question why and then present arguments that this is the worst of times. If you throw caution to the wind and ask how they are, they will list each malady, mention every injustice committed against them, and tell you who is on their black list of family and friends.

What's their problem you might ask. There are many possible answers. The most basic one is that they are unhappy with themselves. They fail to perceive that they are part of God's creation. They think of themselves isolated from the love of God and other creatures. They are. Not because it is God's will that they are in a downward spiral of self pity but because they have withdrawn from an appreciation of God's love and mercy in their lives. They see others only as potential rivals, enemies, threats. Because they are unhappy their mission is to make others the same way.

During this Year of Faith all of us must recognize how precious we are in the eyes of God, how he wants to hear about our day and what our needs might be, and we must look around us and see His gracious presence in creation. We believe in God but more importantly God believes in us.

Our Journey in Faith -

What kind of world are we leaving our children? For centuries wars have determined the life that people were forced to live. Given the global nature of the present, we are so interconnected with foe and friend alike as indicated by the leaking of classified information regarding the technological practice of recording others' conversations and plans. Seemingly everyone is spying on everybody else. This could be acceptable if only peace were the desired outcome of international dialogue. But living as we do is a world wherein everyone of us vie with each other and are engaged in plotting against each other; the outcome looks bleak and wars seem to be inevitable. What separates us one from another are socioeconomic and political differences. Religion as understood by some is also a divisive factor in our relationship with each other.

What we need is what Jesus commanded and that is peace. We must be agents of peace, sharing with each other a sense of brotherhood/sisterhood. Christian charity can work miracles, if only we would practice it.

From a small group of twelve the Lord entrusted the salvation of the world. What a vast change would take place in our world if we were to take Jesus' message and concertize it to the world of today in terms that people understand: peace, justice, love, friendship, sharing, caring, tolerance, honesty, integrity and authenticity. It would be refreshing to hear and experience such positive ideas.
