Our Year in Faith - Sometime ago an author wrote a book claiming everything we know we learned in kindergarten. There is much truth to this. In the early days of our religious education our teachers taught us about the types of prayer. They chose the word ACTS to help summarize the lessons they wanted to impart.

The letter A in Acts stands for adoration. In our modern day adoration is common, but not adoration of the divine. We think too often that accomplishments are self-made. We do not recognize that behind each of our deeds is the presence of the Divine. It is God who gives us our abilities. We must come to adore the cause of our hope, Jesus Christ. The Trinity of Persons in one God is to be ever adored by separating ourselves from the frenetic activity of the world. Jesus went aside alone to pray, so must we.

Which one of us does not need to offer a prayer of Contrition at the end of our day? How important is it to participate in a personal examination of conscience before we retire for the night! Humility is truth. Humbly we must approach the Lord and repent knowing that the gift of mercy is always ours when we seek it.

Thanksgiving should not be a day but an attitude. It is truly an act of faith when we pray in gratitude for the gifts we have received and which we sought but even more when we receive more than we ever expected or deserved.

Supplication comes at the end but it is still important. By recognizing that we should pray for a divine favor we are saying that we are recognizing God as the giver of all good gifts. But before we ask for a blessing we must always praise Him. No thing is too small, nor too great, but we must always conclude His will be done.

So now on this summer day, PRAY: for the Church, for our Country, for the family, for ourselves. We adore You merciful God and thank You for Your many gifts.

Our Journey in Faith -

The parable of the Good Samaritan is Christ's answer to the question "Who is my neighbor" and it should inspire us to go and do the same ourselves. Day after day we see footage of foreign wars in various countries and we wonder if there are any neighborly people left. There seems to be so many categories of people who just plain hate each other that it is easy for them to shoot and kill. Such venom is hard to understand how we have come to treat each other with utter disregard. Has humanity descended to some lower category of being or have we rejected standards of human behavior contrary to human nature and settled for a subhuman life that admits chaos and violence as its norm.

We stand aside just wondering how all this will end. Egypt, Syria, Afghanistan have lost many people in their so called "Arab Spring". How many more will be called to surrender their lives? Can our country in the name of civilization do more to bring peace to our fellow beings? Can we be the Samaritans on life's journey and do more than root for a winner. Democracy may have begun in an infamous way but holds out the possibility of a peaceful conclusion. Yes, liberty, equality and fraternity are admirable goals for all to attain.
