Our Year in Faith - This week we celebrate the feast of St. Martha. She, her sister, Mary, and brother, Lazarus were seen by many of the contemporaries of Jesus as very close friends of Jesus. He would see in their home in Bethany a place of solace. There He was able to enjoy their company without fear of controversy. It was a place where He could engage in friendly banter or isolate Himself to take some time to commune with His Father.

These concepts of friendship can be seen in the Scriptures this weekend. When we read the words of Genesis we can marvel at the patience the Almighty shows towards Abraham. In just hearing it proclaimed we are tempted to cry out: Enough already with all the ands, ifs, and buts, of our father in faith. Why does God endure this questioning? Because He loves Abraham, because He loves us. God listens to the man He created and called to lead many nations. That is true friendship. Listening when is difficult is a gift we must share with those with whom we are in a relationship.

Carrying forward the theme of friendship Jesus teaches His disciples how to pray. He gives them words of support but also challenges. They will receive their daily bread for the Lord will deny His friends nothing which they require but they, for their part, must avoid evil. As the Lord has extended mercy to them so they must forgive the faults of others. "For the measure they have handed out to others will be handed back to them." While they are not to babble on like the pagans do, the Lord encourages them to be persistent in prayer. The Lord reminds His disciples at the time and us who pray that He knows what is best for us. We must not be praying as we too often do: "My will be done." We must be open to the response that will always come even if it is not what we wanted or expected. Very often God shows us in more powerful ways that which we could ever imagine. In friendship with the Father, Son, and Spirit our thoughts, words and actions must be united: "Thy will be done."

Our Journey in Faith

Christ taught us all to call God "Our Father". We are His children and like all children if we need anything we ask our father for it and it will be given to us, or so we hope. There are many times however when He chooses to have another plan for us to follow. What is definite is that God hears our prayer which is a way of saying that He is with us as He promised. What we are assured of is God's love and concern. Moreover, He gives us the grace to bear what has befallen us, the strength to keep going, and the refusal to surrender to hopelessness. Above all we must remind ourselves that we are of God, adopted as His children through the loving salvation of Christ. For us Christ suffered on the cross and gave His life so that we may live with God. Do not despair for beyond this life awaits eternity - life with God forever. So there is nothing to fear for the Lord is with us. So ask, and it will be given to you; search and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.

It is this faith that we have and must share with our children for the world often presents a tragic picture. For a Christian, a follower of Jesus, life can unfold for us the bright promise of immortality and life with God forever.
