Our Year in Faith - This weekend we find ourselves in the midst of the Fortnight of Freedom. For two weeks our American Bishops have urged us to focus on the need of all human beings to be free to believe and act upon that belief in the decisions they make daily. Our shepherds use as the basis of their call the Scriptures in which man's dignity is stressed and Jesus quoted the prophet Isaiah to "proclaim captives free." They realize that down through history the Church has fought for liberty. Many came to our shores for the very reason that they sought the ability to follow the promptings of their conscience. Catholics fought not only for their own liberation but for the free expression of others who would come to our nation's shores.

When the Second Vatican Council was called many of the attendees felt that the value of religious freedom must be expressed as a fundamental human right. They stood and proclaimed for all to hear: The Vatican Council declares that the human person has the right to religious freedom. Freedom of this kind means that all men should be immune from coercion on the part of individuals, social groups and every human power so that, within due limits, no one is forced to act against his convictions in religious matters in private or in public...The Council further declares that the right to religious freedom is based on the very dignity of man...This right of the human person to religious freedom must be given such recognition in the constitutional order of society as will make it a civil right"(2)

Join us all in prayer that what we hoped for in the past for others will return to us. Let July 4th be a celebration of basic freedom for all.
