Our Year in Faith - Palm Sunday begins for us the commemoration of Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection. As a community of faith we are challenged to recognize that His sacrifice has made our salvation possible. It is important, therefore, that we spend as much time as possible mediating upon the Paschal Mystery especially by attending the various services offered in our parishes. Deeply aware that it was for our sins that He took the insults, whippings, and nails we should take the time to participate in the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Monday. On Tuesday evening at Saint Patrick's Cathedral Cardinal Dolan will bless the Holy Oils and Chrism that will be used in the celebration of the sacraments throughout the Archdiocese. Additionally and equally important many priests of the community, diocesan and religious, will renew their promises as they seek to continue to serve all in a faithful manner. Holy Thursday reminds of that Upper Room and the institution of the Sacrament of the Eucharist, the center of our Catholic Lives. On Good Friday, we witness the darkness of evils' seeming victory as the Lord "hands over His spirit" on the Cross. But the Vigil of Saturday proclaims: Christ our Light is among us: not in the tomb any longer for He is risen. Easter has come: Alleluia. For those of us who gather each week Holy Week is a confirmation of the importance of what we do every Sunday. But we know as well that on this day and perhaps on Good Friday there are among us brothers and sisters we don't see often enough. But this week they identify themselves as desirous of being in the presence of the Lord. Why? Does it matter? Let us make them welcome. No one should subject another to judgment. As our humble Pope Francis I has demonstrated it is our task to build up the church by our witness. As his smile has won the hearts of many let our smiles greet those with whom we share Christ Jesus.

### Our Journey in Faith -

As we celebrate this Palm Sunday, we begin a most solemn re-presentation of the final days of Jesus in His ministry. Jesus, who was born in a stable thirty-three years before, so directed His life that it would culminate in the completion of His work. Everything He said and did pointed to these final events. For He came to save us and just like the sacrifices of the Old Testament it would require a sacrifice of Himself.

However, to make sure we would never forget Him, He left us a sacramental real presence of Himself. Gathered around a table with His disciples, He took bread and wine and said, "This is my body and this is my blood. Take and eat; take and drink. For this is a new covenant... do this in memory of me." In that last supper Jesus anticipated the sacrifice of Himself on the cross. He empowered those who sat with Him to repeat His words and to make real to the end of time His presence among us.

In our celebration of Holy Thursday let us cherish this unique gift of Himself to us. Let us glorify and praise the blessed sacrament that spiritually nourishes us all the days of our life.

Let us not ever separate our union with the Lord, especially in the trying moments of life and its decline. Jesus on Good Friday hung on a cross to encourage us to carry the crosses we bear and to point to the fact that with God all is possible. His agony and desolation only gives us strength and courage, especially knowing that He did this for us. Through His absolute giving of Himself, we learn to give and to sacrifice for others.

All these wonderful events of Jesus' final days among us direct our minds to ask why. As the ancients would say: "love has its reasons which reason doesn't know." We humbly believe that Jesus wants us with Him forever. His resurrection from the dead is ours. He lived, died, and rose for us. To be with Him forever is His gift!
