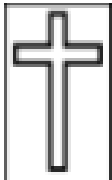

Our Year in Faith - Alleluia! He is risen! He has risen indeed! May the joy of Easter be with you and your family! As the spring begins to unfold the Christian community welcomes the reality that the sadness of the Cross has given way to the joy of the Empty Tomb. The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us clearly that "Belief in the resurrection has been an essential element of the Christian faith from its beginnings" (991). This is verified by reading the Apostle Paul as well as the Fathers of the Church such as Justin, Irenaeus, and Tertullian. Because of this great gift we have the hope of our own eternity with the Father. All too often one hears from people when they refer to their present day troubles that they are in "hell". With a note of compassion we must say "Nonsense". For hell has as its central component: eternal alienation from God and total deprivation of loving companionship. Hell is the great abyss as the Gospel proclaims from which there is no escape nor can there be any relief given from anyone residing in eternal bliss. And though we have heaven as a possibility given to us through the blood of the Lamb we still possess the freedom to reject the salvation won for us and choose the self-destruction of damnation. More positively, let us realize that the Resurrection is a key to the truth that the Lord has not left us orphans but is our constant guide and source of strength, especially in the Eucharist. Again, the Catechism teaches: "Death is transformed by Christ Jesus, the Son of God, also Himself suffered the death that is part of the human condition. Yet, despite his anguish as he faced death, he accepted it in an act of complete and free submission to his Father's will. The obedience of Jesus has transformed the curse of death into a blessing." Our Journey in Faith -

A Blessed Easter to all our wonderful parishioners! You know of course that Easter has special relevance. It is in fact a day that is destined to come at some point in our lives. God will call us to Himself to be with Him forever.

How awesome is this day, for Jesus who lived and died among us has been raised from the dead and promised that those who live and believe in Him will enjoy like resurrection. What a great supernatural gift to receive from God, especially in light of our natural end. But to actively appreciate it we need to attune ourselves to Jesus - to see through faith things in, through, and with Him.

The body of Jesus on Easter morning was quite different from the body of Jesus that was buried on Good Friday afternoon. It was not a resurrected body, that is a body restored to its original life - like Lazarus or the son of the widow of Naim. Rather it was a body that had taken a quantum leap forward into an infinitely higher life. It was a glorified body - totally living and totally life-giving.

We hope to share in Jesus' resurrection. When our body is buried it is mortal; when raised it too will be immortal, no longer a physical body, but a spiritual one.

As St. Paul says, "The truth is that Christ has been raised from death, as the guarantee that those who sleep in death will also be raised ... we will wear the likeness of The Man from heaven." (1 Cor 15:20-22, 49)

And for this we don't have to wait until we die to share in the risen life and power of Jesus. Each time we truly love and hope we share in the resurrection. Nothing can destroy us if we put our faith in Him. All we have to do is open our hearts to the grace that Jesus won for us on that first Easter Sunday some 2,000 years ago. It is for this reason we sing alleluia, alleluia.
