The Ascension of the Lord - May 9th is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses will be held at 6:45am, 9am, 12 noon and 7pm. Please make every effort to attend.

Our Year in Faith - Next week each of us will pay tribute to the women who gave us life and nurtured us. Whether they have gone to God or are still in our midst we will express our gratitude for their many sacrifices. But as we begin the month of May we recall the one mother who gives all, male and female, the example of faith which draws us closer to Christ. When reflecting on the life of the Blessed Mother we should not think that her significance begins with her acceptance of Gabriel's call. To respond positively to the angel she had to be prepared in an environment of spiritual devotion and charity. Her parents shared with her the knowledge of a loving God who created us freely and invited all to participate in His nature of love. Her yes was a culmination of their efforts to ensure that she would be a person of faith prepared to follow where God would lead. As such she did not know the full impact of her assent but trusted that the words she heard would be fulfilled.

When some have difficulties they cry out "Why Me?" Mary could have certainly stated that over and over again. But her confident faith was her companion. Mary's many challenges are only partially recorded in the Gospels. Like all humanity each day experience the highs and lows of life. It is important to note that though she received the unique honor of being the Mother of God she was not exempted from earthly burdens of life and death. It is further noted that she remained faithful at all times exemplifying her instruction to all: "Do whatever He tells you." Devotion to the Virgin Mary does not take away from our relationship with Christ. Indeed, it enhances it. Her rosary which should be said often but especially now gives us a catechesis of the love of God and the life of Christ. Praising the Mother brings joy to the Son. When tempted to cry out against our trials in life, let us remember her. Let us call upon her for the gift of patient endurance and strong faith. Mother, remember me to your Son. Keep us faithful to Him as you were and are.

Our Journey in Faith -

On Thursday we celebrate the feast of The Ascension, a holy day of obligation. This feast recalls Jesus, The Christ, return to the Father from whence He was sent to us. Before Jesus suffered and died on the cross He prayed that The Holy Spirit be sent so that His teachings and grace-filled life would be adopted by us. Although Jesus is in Heaven, His life, message, and Spirit are very much a part of our life. His words at the last supper, "Do this in memory of me," constitute a summons to which we turn constantly, for we live in, through, and with Him.

We must also remember that the love that Jesus has for us perdures forever. He is our foremost intercessor before The Father and with the angels and saints they constitute a vast assembly asking for God's mercy upon us. Our liturgy of the mass anticipates the heavenly liturgy that forever is celebrated in heaven.

So there is not only a connection we have with Christ who suffered, died and rose for us, but a living link, a Spirit driven life that we must pursue daily, a life of prayer and good deeds, that reflects our love for God and neighbor, empowered by Jesus' gift of The Spirit and His heavenly intercession. We must never be separated from the love of God in Jesus Christ, our Lord.
