Our Year in Faith - It is truly ironic the manner in which society treats marriage. To some it is an unnecessary convention; to others the celebration of the ceremony requires months of preparation which leads to the expending of thousands of dollars, much of which is borrowed. Because of the two extremes and points in between the wonder and mystery of married life is missed and the knowledge of sacramental holiness is absent. In St. John's Gospel we hear Jesus define love as the Last Supper in His instructions to the disciples and as He hung upon the Cross. Out of love for the wedding couple at Cana He performed His first miracle. As a Church we realize the presence that blessed them, blesses all who declare themselves for each other before the community of the People of God. With the apostles and evangelists utilizing the marital union as symbolic of the relationship between Christ and His Church we recognize the qualities necessary for every Catholic marriage.

Christ tells His Apostles that they are to love one another as He loves them. He tells them as well that He will be with them all days. That sense of permanency is to be mirrored in each man and woman who stand before the ecclesial community and declare their love. The concept of permanency seems almost alien in our time. To some the word "permanent" means a life sentence with no chance for parole. The Church's understanding however, along with that of every wedded couple is that the relationship centers them and the sacramental graces strengthen them. If we have learned anything about our earthly life, it is that it is uncertain reality which can change direction and destiny in the twinkling of an eye. With the assistance of the Sacrament of Marriage well-lived, a couple can face any joy or sorrow, any opportunity or burden, and any crisis or challenge with the utmost confidence that they will experience it as one entity fulfilling the plan of God made in Genesis. One hand, One heart, One life.

Our Journey in Faith -

Among the many concerns of the early Church was the need to take care of the more dependent members of the Church - the widows, the orphans, foreigners. This necessitated the creation of deacons - dedicated to serving the nascent communities. The apostles prayed over them and upon them laid their hands thus empowering them in their ministry. Passing on their faith in Christ was the early Church's main concern. Both to Jews and non-Jews (Gentiles) the good news of salvation won by the crucified and resurrected Christ impelled them to reach out. Groups formed and both homes and synagogues were places to gather for prayer and praise. In some settings 'the breaking of the bread' was celebrated and thus we see the beginnings of Eucharist. As time went by, the life and gospel of Jesus was passed on orally and then written accounts came to be executed. The oral accounts were in Aramaic; the common language that Jesus spoke, and the written accounts were in Greek. Between 65AD and 70AD the first of the Synoptic Gospels, Mark, was written. It was called 'synoptic' because of its similarity to the gospels of Matthew and Luke. It was written for non-Palestinian Christians of pagan origin. Matthew's gospel was written about 70AD and addressed itself to Jewish Christians. The last of the synoptic gospels was written by Luke, a physician and of pagan origin. He wrote primarily for Gentiles and showed a favoritism for minorities, segregated groups, and the underprivileged. Samaritans, lepers, publicans, public sinners, unlettered shepherds, the poor - all received encouragement from him.

So you see that from the beginning Christ's message was for everyone. No one was to be ignored. Special effort was made to reach those generally forgotten in society.
