The Year in Faith - In this month of remembrance the Church has set aside November 3rd to celebrate the Feast of Saint Martin de Porres. Because of his life and ministry he is known as the Patron of Social Justice. Pope Francis has reminded us that this is a constitutive element of faith. The truth of this assertion can be seen easily in the Church's history beginning with the Scriptures. The Apostles following the teachings of their Jewish ancestors had a fund by which they assisted the poor. Jesus, Himself, multiplied the loaves and fish so that having been spiritually feed the people would not lack the nourishment necessary to return to home and family. One of the first acts of the Apostles was to respond to the needs of the widows and orphans of the community by the ordination of seven deacons who would dispense the necessary charity to them. Our first leaders certainly must have had in mind the admonitions of the prophets that justice demanded that the poor be served in such a way. As centuries went on the overseers or bishops of the community would seek to protect the more vulnerable in their society from abuse. We remember the works of Leo XIII, Pius XI, Blessed John XXIII, Paul VI, and Blessed John Paul II. They called for employment freedom, living wages, dignity of women, against child labor, and the formation of groups bring peace and justice to society. May the spirit of Saint Martin de Porres guide us in this area where faith must be revealed in action.

Our Journey in Faith -

This gospel account of Jesus coming to the town of Jericho is heartwarming because it shows to what great length we go to meet Him and welcome Him. Zacchaeus was not going to permit his small stature to prevent his seeing Jesus and Jesus rightly acknowledged Zacchaeus and asked if He could stay with him and his family that night. By climbing a tree Zacchaeus evidenced his enthusiasm for the Lord. To what lengths do we go to welcoming Jesus into our midst? It is pathetic to claim your devotion to Jesus and then to deny Him an hour of praise and thanksgiving on a Sunday morning. And yet at the end of our lives we expect Jesus to be waiting for us. How do we interpret His words at the last supper, "Do this in memory of me." He awaits us at His table and expects us to attend. What is keeping us from this wonderful encounter. Surely we can overcome it and be like Zacchaeus.
