The Year in Faith - As we look forward to the canonization of two modern popes there is a certain value in examining their contributions to the life of the church in which we celebrate our faith. This week we will focus on the importance of Karol Wojtyla, Blessed John Paul II. As one of the youngest Bishops of the Second Vatican Council he was instrumental in the formulation of the decree on religious freedom. As one would imagine coming from a country oppressed first by Nazism and then Communism, this was a major concern for him. He witnessed his fellow citizens often opposing these forces, paying ultimately the supreme price for faithfulness. In a second decree's debate at the council he was also vocal: *Nostri Aetate*. His personal lifelong friendship with Jewish neighbors strengthened his resolve to change the church's perspectives. He saw the damage of Holocaust as destructive of human dignity. He subscribed to the final promulgated document fully. "One is the community of all peoples, one their origin, for God made the human race to live over the face of the earth. One also is their final goal, God. His providence, His manifestation of goodness. His saving design extended to all men, until that time when the elect will be unified in the Holy City, the city ablaze with the Glory of God, where the nations will walk in His light."

The Pope would remind all that dialogue is not about the task of watering down ones faith but about enhancing each tradition and enhancing the ability to mutual understand one another. Praise God for these times of growing in the love of God.

### Our Journey in Faith -

In our society there are very few links between God and humanity and modern jurisprudence is used to untangle whatever remains. Suit after suit is issued to remove every vestige of any 'God talk' so as to leave us orphaned of our roots and aimless of our final destiny. But if you take Jesus seriously there is no denying that He believed and taught 'resurrection', not as an escape from earthly reality but as the fulfillment of our earthly yet spiritual lives. What Jesus taught He lived through and still endures. "I am the resurrection and the life. He who lives in me shall not die but have life everlasting." It is upon this that we place our faith, hope, and love, and I must say, our fearless acceptance of the future.
