**The Year in Faith** - Every Catholic Christian is called to recognize the Word of God especially when it is proclaimed at Mass. But sad to say the Old Testament is frequently ignored. It is incorrectly perceived as having less value than the more familiar New Testament especially the Gospels. This is to our detriment. The experiences of "our elder brothers in faith" should be allowed to inform our relationship with God. This is the touchstone for Christ's preaching. Today we hear from Exodus and Luke about prayer and the necessity of persistence in beseeching the Lord. As we all know prayers of intercession or supplication are truly acts of faith in that they acknowledge that God is the giver of all good gifts. He is the ultimate source of life for us as individuals and as a community.

Following the ideas postulated in the Old Testament Luke's Gospel tells us that God is much greater than us in the generosity he shows when we call upon Him for the fulfillment of our needs. But he reflects in a concerned way that when the Son of Man returns will He find us watching in prayer. Will He be greeted by people of faith? That is what this Year of Faith is all about. We must remain persistent in our prayer and love. The Lord will not force Himself upon us. There must be in us the spirit of Peter who cried out in confession: "Lord to whom shall we go? You have the words of everlasting life". Let us pray for each other and for our world to the Lord of life and of salvation.

### Making All Things New -

Our hearts are heavy this weekend as we think of the death of Kalie Gill. Why she should die is known only by God and we tremble to think of her passing. This tragedy like all others brings us to reflect on how truly tentative life is. In a single instant one can expire. How quickly life is over as we have experienced it and it forces us to seek what is beyond. Were it not for Jesus we would be dumbfounded to explain our passing. He comes to us in the simple story of Martha, Mary, and Lazarus. They were friends of Jesus, people with whom He could relax, enjoying their company. Lazarus took sick and died. His sisters were frantic and prayed that Jesus be with them. When He arrived Martha told Him how upset they were and how their brother would not have died if He had been with them. Jesus reassured them that their brother would live in the resurrection from dead, that He was Lord of the dead and the living. And to demonstrate that truth Jesus called Lazarus from the tomb.

In the face of human suffering Jesus does not abandon us. His Holy Spirit guides us to reach out to Him who is Lord of the dead and the living. It is our faith that if we die in the Lord, we shall rise with Him. We take comfort in His words: "I am the Resurrection and the Life. He who believes in me, even though He should die, shall have life everlasting." With that in our minds and hearts, we pray for Kalie.
