The Year in Faith - At the end of this week we commence celebrating a month of remembrance of those who have gone before us. As the book of Maccabees tells us it is a noble thing to pray for the dead (2Mac 12: 39-46). As Catholic Americans we remember those who came to this land to settle it as immigrants, who participated in the forming of our nation, and most importantly, those who passed on the faith to us. We begin this time with the festival of the holy ones: All Saints' Day. Who are these men and woman we honor? Many are known and canonized: Francis, Catherine, Peter, Ignatius, Dominic, Therese, Gianna and so many more. Others are known and yet to be raised to the dignity of the altar: Terence, Dorothy, Pierre, Fulton, and so many more. Still others are known but to smaller groups and yet revered just as well. From their heavenly throne may they intercede us.

As Catholics we recognize that the state of purgatory exists to take care of the temporary punishment due to sin (sin that has been forgiven on earth). On November 2nd we remember the souls yet to enter into paradise. We can assist them with prayer, especially the Mass. Through several methods we might be able to obtain a plenary indulgence to be applied to our deceased. It is our opportunity to do the greatest work of charity which was mentioned in Maccabees to pray for our dead. Let us realize our need for God's mercy and the intercession of those who have died and see the face of God.

Our Journey in Faith -

One of the most difficult persons that one has to bear is a braggart, a person filled with self-importance and having an ego of gigantic proportions. Since Jesus emphasized humility, it is easy to see why He found such people as intolerable. "Woe to you Pharisees and lawyers," said He because they have imposed heavy burdens on others and did nothing to help them. They held everyone else in contempt.

The importance of humility cannot be overstated. One's life must be grounded in humility, linked to service, and propelled by a desire to devote one's efforts to the greater glory of God. The dominant values of our faith as Catholics are love, humility, collaboration, sacrifice, service, and care for the poor.

As is obvious, these are not the values of our contemporary culture, and our secular society. For Christians are invited to be counter-cultural - even to washing the feet of others, to work not just for oneself but for the good of all. "For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."
