Our Year in Faith - With the arrival of Labor Day our level of activity increases exponentially. But before we are overwhelmed by life's external forces, we should resolve to develop a spiritual attitude of detachment. We would define such as: interior freedom. St. Ignatius of Loyola counseled radical detachment. He stated that: "We should not fix our desire on health or sickness, wealth or poverty, success or failure, a long life or a short one". Our one goal is the freedom to make a whole hearted choice to follow God.

We can see how one person, Pope Francis, lives out this concept on a daily basis. By his words and actions he is giving us an example of how it is possible to prioritize one's goals and the means to achieve them. His choice of residence in the Domus Sancte Marthae demonstrates a desire for modesty in dwelling. It is entirely understandable for a family to wish to live in a house which offers comfort, community, and privacy. But in today's society to have an expensive and unique home becomes an obsession for too many.

Detachment also pertains to the daily lives of us all. No matter how young or old we are a reflective people who are obligated to set forth priorities in the fulfillment of tasks. The primary question which must be answered at all points is: "Does this work advance my friendship with Christ and my eternal destiny?" Too many adults surround themselves with tools for advancement, friendships which promise promotion, and habits which guarantee financial protection without referencing the fact that death is a reality and judgment is a certainty.

Like the Pope, each of us in a prayerful manner must participate in an examination of conscience not only to root out evil but to arrange in order those goods which will bring us God's blessings and human fulfillment. May the Holy Family guide us each day.

Our Journey in Faith

When my father died in 1972, I vividly recall the family discussing what was appropriate for dad's tombstone. There was genuine agreement that dad be singled out for his humility and a beautiful phrase from the scriptures was chiseled on the stone. For us who were left he embodied all the characteristics of a humble man. He truly was an example to be followed.

In today's readings Jesus is teaching what is important in order to enter the Kingdom of God "everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted" the very text inscribed on my dad's cemetery stone. Jesus singles out humility for it opens the door to every other virtue. "Learn from me for I am meek and humble of heart" (Mt 11:29). Humility counteracts willful pride wherein we solely listen to ourselves, blocking the divine from entering. Such pride causes us to look down on others who are not as good as we think we are, to treat them with disdain.

Living as we do in a multiracial, multicultural environment, we should learn from each other so as to embrace a broader picture and thus to render to each one his due. Jesus' words of admonition, "love one another", is how we should approach our neighbors. Respect for each person - no matter the differences- is a humble way to live and it is a Godly way, for He has created us all. And this is exactly the memory I have of my father.
