The Year in Faith

September 8th marks the celebration of the Nativity of Mary. Therefore it is an appropriate time to reflect on her importance to every Catholic, indeed, every lover of the Lord Jesus Christ. All too often her role in the forming of our spirituality is misunderstood. We honor the Blessed Mother not as a goddess but as one of us; a human being called to be faithful. But even members of the Catholic community do not appreciate the nature of her life's journey. They fail to perceive the depth of sacrifice that was present in every moment of her existence. When we read the Scripture we must appreciate the human drama behind the events portrayed. When the virgin is approached by the angel and her response was to accept the Lord's will that was only the beginning of the story. She then had to tell her parents that she was to become an unwed mother. Joseph would question her fidelity but be reassured by an angel and believe. When she was in her ninth month she had to go with Joseph to Bethlehem. Her Son would be born as part of a homeless family. They would be forced to flee from Herod and live as refugees in Egypt.

They rejoiced when they were told they could return to Galilee and the town of Nazareth. The young family were glad to be with their relatives. Jesus and Joseph would spend so much time together. He learned a great deal about his foster father's trade on a daily basis. Mary becomes a young widow. She cannot fend for herself. Jesus saw to the fulfillment of their needs. Then the day came when He knew He had to leave and begin His public ministry but they would remain close. Then the final days of His earthly mission came about. She wept for Him. She mourned the rejection of the people who He came to save. She mourned the faithlessness of the fearful apostles. She mourned for the loss of her only Son. But throughout she was faithful. And from the Cross she accepted the call of her Son to receive John and us into her care. She would not be called to her Queenship in heaven until she prayed in the Upper Room for the Holy Spirit's presence in the birth of the Church.

Mary is to be honored for she never left Her Son nor will she leave us but will bring us to Him.
