Making All Things New - This week our parish Core Team attended the first training session of the Archdiocesan initiative of Making All Things New. The session was for them to become acquainted with the materials we will be using to assess our parish ministries. The Core Team is made up of Fr. Healy, Mrs. Purce, Mr. Gaglione, Mrs. Franchi, Mr. Terry, Mr. Jeremias.

The Core Team will be overseeing the evaluation of parish ministries based on the Criteria for Planning. The Criteria are divided into four categories: Sacramental Life of the Parish; Evangelization, Catechesis, Catholic Schools and Lifelong Religious Education; Stewardship and Outreach; and Effective Administration.

The Core Team will be working with parishioners to learn about and assess parish life in order to enhance the vitality of parish life by planning for the future. This will be done through a series of surveys and meetings that you will be asked to participate in. Your input is extremely valuable for the success of this program. The emphasis is that we are in conversation with each other and everyone's input is important.

Mass Intentions for 2014 are now being taken in the rectory. The cost is \$15 per said mass.
