Our Journey in Faith

We hear of hunger and death due to starvation on television and read in the newspaper of terrible famine that ravages towns and regions in Asia, Africa, Latin America and Caribbean islands. Hunger is not of God's making; it is we, man who brought it upon ourselves, as we brought all other evil on account of our choice of sin and evil. It is the selfishness of man that perpetuates hunger. The world can easily produce all the food that mankind needs: but there are many, who can afford, but waste and destroy food for various reasons. Almost all the countries including the poor countries spend large sums of money in weapons, money that would more than suffice to feed everyone in the country.

Our spirit, just as our body, must be fed. We may have enough food and drink that we need, yet feel far from satisfied. The human heart longs for happiness and no amount of material things can quench his thirst for it. Family, possessions, human love, satisfy our heart's longing for happiness but only to a point. Eventually the only one who can fully satisfy man's spiritual hunger and thirst is God.

Augustine who tried everything that he could afford in his life to bring happiness and found himself dissatisfied that he finally turned to God and found the fountain of life and happiness. He finally summed up his experience in saying "you have made us for you, O Lord, and our hearts cannot be satisfied till it finds it finds rest in you."

While physical hunger is beyond one's own power to remedy, spiritual hunger is often self-inflicted. We ourselves go often hungry because we neglect or refuse to take the spiritual food that God has provided for us in abundance. Jesus works miracles not only to feed the people but also to help both, apostles and people, to understand the lesson he would explain on the next day at Capernaum, that he himself was to be man's food in three ways: through faith, through his teachings and above all through the Holy Eucharist. Ultimately it is the message of God's infinite love for us.

Jesus sends no one away empty; he feeds and satisfies. God is on our side. His love and generosity knows no ends. We are called everyday to share His love at the Eucharistic table. In the Eucharist Jesus breaks himself to feed us with His own Body. Our participation will be full to the extent we 'break ourselves' of our selfishness for others sakes and be sensitive to the needs of the less fortunate. Thus during Holy Mass, we give, we receive, we share, by cooperating with the creative and redemptive plan of God.
