Our Journey in Faith

Love is more powerful than hatred and evil. The love of God is even more powerful than all our weaknesses, sins and failings. The cross is the proof for God's unconditional love. The cross was once considered an instrument of shame and death but it took on a profound new meaning after Jesus' resurrection.

The readings of today, on the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, present to us the wonderful plan of God's love for humankind. God sustained and healed the Israelites in spite of their rebellion and grumbling against Him in the wilderness. The bronze serpent on the pole too symbolized the salvific act of God and His mercy when He delivered them from those venomous serpents. Unlike the Israelites' unfaithfulness, Jesus obeyed and submitted himself to God's will. In the second reading, Paul describes the self-emptying love of Jesus to fulfill his Father's plan. He was ready to bear every pain, suffering and shame for the sinful humanity because he was the one who had come to manifest and reveal God's unconditional love to us. Jesus, in the gospel, explains the unfathomable mystery of God's love in giving up His only Son for the world. Like the raising of the bronze serpent in the wilderness, the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross has become the new symbol of God's saving and transforming love for us.

Today the Cross invites you and me, all of us Christians, to enact this new covenant of love in everyday situations of our lives. No matter what life threw at us, we accept them joyfully considering that God who gave us life, who bought us up to this day has something better planned for us through this pain that we are called to go through. If only we accept suffering and pain in the total faith in Jesus, we would experience the strength to bear them with joy. Today let us just bow our heads in adoration to God and thank Him for the love He has revealed to us through Jesus Christ.
