Our Journey in Faith

Continuing our conversation about God's interaction with humanity, we have a wonderful explanation of how God's Son, Jesus, assumes our humanity and through this humanity saves us. St. Paul when speaking of Jesus, the Son of God, writes that He empties himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human appearance; He humbles Himself becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. In other words, God's Son became incarnate (human flesh) in a moment of history and lived a humble, human life, giving Himself in pursuing God's will, which led to his death on the cross for our salvation. Jesus associated with the poor, the needy, the sick and lepers; His followers were simple, ordinary people. There was nothing aristocratic in His demeanor nor was He associated with the powerful of the day. On the contrary, He was looked upon as a interloper, an anomaly, to the priests, pharisees, and lawyers of His day. At best, for His time, He was considered marginal to the mainstream of Judaism. Yet, in hindsight we can say that He captured the underlying yearning of the people and His life, message, and Spirit set the world on fire with His love and forgiveness.

His supreme sacrifice on the cross shines forth as His greatest accomplishment transforming human suffering into the greatest gift humanity has ever received. With Jesus, death becomes life, not just for now but for eternity. Having died on the cross, He has raised us to His eternal glory.
